CARIBBEAN CARNIVAL – By Museumand, The National Caribbean Heritage Museumand

Did you know ...?

Lockdown has caused some health concerns! "Corona has mashed up Carnival this year!"

has been a familiar phrase among Caribbean Carnival organisers up and down the land this year. Some who refuse to be beaten by the virus have organised online Carnival sessions instead. But what exactly is Carnival and why is it so important to Caribbean culture?

Carnival has a long and rich history going all the way back to Egypt, before becoming a feature of many other cultures over time. In Africa, Carnival is a more spiritual affair, while here in the UK, contemporary Carnival has become a celebration of Caribbean culture in multicultural Britain - and a mega street party. Traditionally, English towns have had street parades and fetes, but Caribbeans introduced a new way of bringing people together back in the late 1950s, when the Windrush Generation brought Caribbean music and dance with them to the UK including Calypso and Reggae, along with cultural traditions like Carnival.

Nottingham was the first city in the UK to hold a Caribbean Carnival, when Caribbean residents in The Meadows, mainly from St Kitts, organised the Nottingham Caribbean Carnival in 1958 to ease community tensions after race riots in the city. A similar event was held in Notting Hill following race riots in London and Notting Hill Carnival went on to become an

international attraction. Nottingham Carnival may not be quite as famous, but the city can be proud that The original Nottingham Caribbean Carnival included food, drink, music and dancing, but many

revellers also dressed up as traditional or Old Mas' characters. Mas' is an abbreviation of Masquerade, another word for a Caribbean Carnival. The form of Mas' brought over to the UK by Caribbeans has its roots in the era of transatlantic slavery, when the French introduced the celebration in Trinidad, wearing ornate costumes and dancing the Quadrille.

Originally reserved for sugar plantation owners and managers, emancipation in 1838 saw freed Africans make the European Mas' their own, by introducing Mas' characters that told their history. "The African" to remind them of where they'd come from, "The Negre Jardin" (Field Slave) who tended the sugar cane fields Europeans depended on for their wealth and power, "The Jab Molassie", said to be the spirit of a slave representing all those who had died producing sugar and rum who would forever haunt plantation owners, "The Red Indian", representing the original inhabitants of the Caribbean isles - the Taino, the Arawaks and the Caribs, and "The Moko Jumbie" a stilt walker said to represent the African god Orisha, the god of fate and retribution who protects people from approaching

The skimpy costumes adorned with sequins, beads and feathers associated with contemporary Carnival are known as "Pretty Mas" because they're bright and beautiful and have evolved from Caribbean Carnival traditions, but they're very different to traditional Mas' costumes.

The Nottingham Carnival we know today started in 1970 and has become a familiar sight, with Carnival floats, dance troupes, bands and performers wending their way around the city. This year's Carnival has been cancelled because of coronavirus and it will be much missed by many, but it does give Nottingham the chance to reflect on the

importance of Carnival as a celebration of Caribbean history and heritage, and its contribution to life in the city.

A group of Nottingham based thespians who all happen to all be diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease are creating a brand new piece of comedy theatre loosely based on the story of Snow White and The Seven Dwarfs, but with added ecology, neurology and laughs for all the family.

Parkinson's activists and fundraisers including Sheila North, Janet Barnes, Peter Harrison and Robert Jaques have not been deterred by neither the Covid-19 crisis nor their condition, but instead have been meeting online creating this brand new theatrical piece. The team are linking up with Beeston Rylands Community Association to enable different groups from the community the chance to contribute to and benefit from the

All active members of the Trent Bridge Parkinsons's cafe, the team are hoping to raise not only vital funds to support the work of Parkinson's UK's, but also to raise awareness of a condition that can affect people of all ages. The aim is to raise funds for research in a fun way, whereby friends, family and the community can get involved.

Parkinson's UK is the leading charity driving better care, treatments and quality of life for those with the condition. Its mission is to find a cure and improve life for everyone affected by Parkinson's through cutting edge research, information, support and campaigning. The team's plan is to have the production ready for performance Spring 2021. Initially the show will be performed at

Beeston Rylands Community Centre, and the ambition is to then take it on tour. Sheila and the team have spent many hours so far creating this unique piece and are now appealing to any local businesses to get involved through sponsorship and support to help put the performance together and ultimately raise money for a cause that is close to their hearts. Janet Barnes said: "We hope to raise awareness of the condition in a fun and positive way. The play is packed full of topical references and

gags, and takes a humorous view point on what is a pretty rotten disease". The show is for everyone, whether you've got connections to PD or not."

"Every penny will make a difference and we're hoping to raise as much as I can." Parkinson's is a progressive neurological condition for which there is currently no cure. It affects around 145,000 people in the UK including 121,927 in England / 12,184 in Scotland / 7,692 in Wales / 3,716 in Northern Ireland. Parkinson's UK estimate that there are more than 40 symptoms of the condition. As well as the most widely known symptom - tremor - these range from physical symptoms like muscle stiffness to depression, anxiety, hallucinations, memory problems and dementia, but Parkinson's affects everyone differently. Katherine Bartrop, Head of Regional Fundraising at Parkinson's UK, said: "Our work supporting people with Parkinson's, and research to find better treatments and a cure for the condition is completely dependent on






# overcoming obstacles

"Naturescape Wildflower Farm is a family owned business based in Langar, Nottinghamshire and specialises in the production of British native wildflower seeds, plants and bulbs. The total area of seed production in 2020 was 300 acres.

The company was founded in 1978 by Brian and Elizabeth Scarborough and has grown over the years to become the largest producer of native wildflower seeds in the UK.

The tearoom and visitor centre based in Langar was opened in 1990 and 45 acres of our wildflower fields are accessible to the public on this site. Visitors have the opportunity to see the wildflower crops and also see what can be achieved in terms of meadows, wildlife ponds and native hedgerows.

A large range of pollinating insects, including bees and butterflies, are attracted to the fields of flowers. The tearoom is now open 7 days a week from 9am to 5pm Monday to Saturday and 10am to 4pm on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

We have a range of wildflower plants available to purchase in 9cm pots along with native climbers, roses and ferns. Native pond plants including water lilies are also available. 250 different species are available to purchase as seed packets and there are a number of different meadow mixtures tailor-made for different habitats.

We closed due to the Coronavirus lockdown on the 23rd March and reopened on the 4th July. We have made a number of changes to the seating arrangement inside and added much more outdoor seating to create a safer environment for our customers and staff.



# gardening

Whilst you certainly should be enjoying your own personal green space and not stressing about working hard in the garden. Right now it is a handy time to see what became of your plans from last year..



### Planning for a full year of flowering

Not entirely happy with everything you see? Think a few areas here and there might have gone better with a bit more care in planting choice? Well, grab a cheap sketch pad or better still, some graph paper and a pencil. Look at the garden as you would if planning a room with walls, floor, 'ceiling' - in this case you may wish to install a tarp or a large parasol type umbrella. Consider any furniture locations - after all you will want to be sitting comfy when you have your garden as you like it!

A three-season garden requires three essential ingredients:

- Perennials that bloom copiously year after year
- Small shrubs with colour-saturated foliage all season long
- Plants that do not spread aggressively

Heuchera, Blackeyes Susan, Salvia and Asters all have these characteristics. Along with your annually bought bedding plants these can move your garden

forwards and help you get nearly year round colour rather than everything going dead at the end of summer.

Before you start planting, you need to create a garden plan by using graph paper and drawing a plan of your garden site to scale (this is not technical: just use one square or four squares to represent one metre in your garden). Plot every feature you find on your site, both natural and those already in place. Grab the measuring tape to get approximate measurements. It's also now helpful to note areas of sun and shade along with where the wind tends to blow - especially if you get any 'tunnel' type effects (wind can really blight plant growth).

Use general terms to express which type of plant might go where e.g sun-loving perennials etc. This way you keep the plan easier to execute later and not get bogged down.

Look forward to an even better garden and as always - Enjoy!

### **JOBS TO KEEP AN EYE ON THIS MONTH**

### The Greenhouse

Greenhouse plants must have regular attention. Tomatoes especially must be watered on a regular basis, as irregular watering will cause the fruit to split. Now is also the time to pinch out the centre shoot of any tomato plants so they can concentrate their growing energy on filling out the existing tomatoes, rather than producing more growth and more flowers.

### **Bedding Plants**

The bedding plants you set out with in early summer with just buds and a few small flowers on them should be in full glory now but to maintain the florid display they must be fed with a liquid feed. Do not overfeed though.

### **Dead Heading**

Always remove any dead flowers on your bedding plants and other decorative plants, if they are left to go to seed the plants will stop flower production before the summer is over.

# for the love of scrubs

Support a fantastic new initiative here in Nottingham

Lockdown may be easing and people may be returning to work, but Nottingham still has a demand for scrubs and face coverings. The Nottingham FTLOS group has teamed up with Tiger Community **Enterprise CIC to** ensure this need can be fulfilled in the

The Nottingham chapter of the national 'For the Love of Scrubs' movement began 13 weeks ago. Originally being set up by three women who just wanted to help and all these weeks later and the group has 1700+ members, have raised £5,500 and have donated over 25,000 items to the NHS, frontline and key workers.

community.

One of the original three founders of the

community, Amy Gathercole joined up with local CIC - Tiger Community Enterprise CIC to offer the project longevity and a central hub. Tiger Community Enterprise CIC usually reside with their community-based textiles project downstairs at 38 Carrington Street but the partners of the Urban Room have kindly allowed them to use the Groundfloor space too, meaning they have a bigger and more accessible space - which is currently housing hundreds of items safely and securely, with volunteer drivers and bikers popping in (at a social distance) to collect items and deliver them across Nottinghamshire to those that need them. In the past 2 weeks 900 masks have been made and donated already, along with around 200 sets of scrubs.

As a way of funding the operation and supplies needed to make more face masks, scrubs and accessories going forward an initiative called 'Buy one, Give one' launched in June, specifically for non-surgical face coverings. This means that for every mask purchased, at least one will be given for free to key workers and frontline workers in the local community who request them.

The moment that the country realised there were not enough scrubs to supply the frontline, any seamstress and sewing enthusiast with access to sewing machines and a fabric stash took up the call to arms and started becoming homebased manufacturers.

There is still a demand for scrubs in local hospitals as well as for workers within the community as more and more professions return to work. Hundreds of wash bags, button headbands, earsavers and scrub hats are still being created after two months too. We are also working with Nottingham & Nottinghamshire Refugee Forum who are helping sew scrubs. However, as time goes on and as people return to work, we now more than ever need support to ensure we have enough fabric and supplies to support the demand.



As for so many organisations, 2020 has been a difficult year for the Canalside Heritage Centre down at Beeston Lock. In line with the national lockdown, staff closed the Heritage Centre to the public in March with heavy hearts and not knowing what the future would hold. As a small, independent charity which relies on the income generated through the onsite tearoom and gift shop, these were potentially devastating circumstances and Canalside was in real danger of closing permanently, having only opened in 2017 after so much

hard work.

Staff, volunteers and trustees, however, were determined that this would not happen, and an online campaign was started to raise much needed funds. The response to this from the local community and beyond was overwhelming and within three days of the campaign going live it had raised over half of the £10,000 total. After a week the total had been surpassed with an amazing £10,724 eventually being raised. Emergency funding from the National Lottery Heritage Fund and financial support from Broxtowe Borough Council also helped to secure the short-term future of the Heritage Centre.

During lockdown the time was used to make the site Covid safe with full social distancing and hygiene measures in place for when the Centre reopened. As well as this, a covered seating area was built in the garden for visitors and a new menu developed for the tearoom. The tearoom reopened in mid-June for a takeaway service and then on 4th July the garden and balcony were opened for visitors to relax and enjoy the tasty treats on offer from the tearoom. Since then business has been steady but it's hoped that more people will visit and enjoy the beautiful and peaceful surroundings on the River Trent, ensuring this community project, so loved by local people, has a bright future.

### **About the Canalside Heritage Centre**

Canalside Heritage Centre is situated at Beeston Lock and is managed and maintained by a small, independent charity. Once a set of weir cottages, the buildings that now comprise the Heritage Centre had been abandoned and unloved for decades. As a result of the vision and hard work of a dedicated group of local people, passionate about engaging people in the heritage of waterways, it is now a welcoming and thriving heritage centre having opened its doors to the local community in June 2017.

# Covid Comeback for Moore Physio

local

Moore Physio has had to endure the lockdown with the rest of us and has now returned strong again and ready to help patients regain mobility throughout their body.

SINCE 2002

Going into lockdown looked like it would spell disaster for our lovingly grown clinic. Initially

we reeled from the sudden loss of patients to treat. Along with the rest of the community we were mourning the loss of what we held most dear. However, in true problem-solving Physiotherapy style we adapted and the pandemic has increased the quality of the service we can provide.

So what changes have we made? During lockdown we moved to online appointments and exercise classes.

As lockdown has eased we have resumed face to face physiotherapy, although exercise classes will remain online for a while longer.

We are running online exercise classes for patients with neurological and mobility problems.

Online classes have been really popular. The patients report that they like the fact they don't have to travel to get to the class as they can do them in the comfort of their own home. We now have plans to expand this service to offer more options for exercising with a disability during lockdown.

The virtual clinic appointments have been more of a challenge.

It is difficult to assess someone's back effectively through a video camera



and not everyone is comfortable using the technology. However, we do still do a virtual first appointment to take a through history, complete a risk assessment and COVID screening and ensure it is safe to see someone in person either at home or in clinic. This has increased the quality of the service we can provide once we meet face to face.

When we see people we have made several adjustments to ensure safety. Our therapists are in appropriate PPE, we leave half an hour between appointments for clean down and refresh of circulating air and we ask you

to wear a mask. All in all what could have been a disaster is fast becoming the new normal and in some respects a better normal.





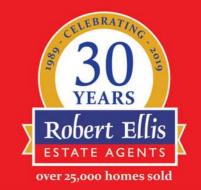
