

Loving Creatives

Have you ever dreamt of designing a dress for Beyoncé, having a book published or even a top 10 record? Past winners of **Nottingham's Young Creative Awards** have done all of these things - and this year's awards are now open.

Entries are open to anyone aged 11 to 24 who lives, works or studies in Nottingham. There are eleven different categories: Animation & Digital Media, Creative Writing, Dance, Design & Architecture, Fashion & Textiles, Film, Graphic Design, Music, Photography, Theatre and Visual Art.

It's free to enter, and with cash prizes and industry opportunities up for grabs, entrants have got nothing to lose and everything to gain. Participants can conjure up something new to submit or show off existing work, including pieces they've done at school, college or university.

It's a brilliant way for Nottingham's young people to show off their talents, develop valuable contacts, and perhaps even to launch a creative career. Winners and finalists will have unique opportunities to take part in exhibitions and showcase events, and to take up work placements and mentoring opportunities with creative businesses in the city.

18 year-old Sarah Mensah, was one of more than 500 young people who entered the Young Creative Awards in 2020. Sarah went on to win the Photography award (16-18 age group) for her beautiful set of studio portraits which explore issues of race and identity. Sarah said: "Winning the YCA 2020 as a young artist gave me recognition for my

work, which led to my first televised interview and publication. This experience has helped me develop confidence in my work, which has led me to work on various creative projects with different organisations such as Nottingham Castle, further developing my creativity and innovation as a young artist."

Last year's Young Creative Awards were celebrated online and through a special one hour special programme on Notts TV. Organisers are planning to build on last year's successes this year and are hoping that exhibitions and events in city centre venues, celebrating this year's participants, will be possible in the autumn.





Holocaust Memorial Day acts as a beacon of light every January that shines on the darkness of genocides that have taken place around the world in the past. 
Each year for the past twenty years Broxtowe Borough Council has held a ceremony at Bramcote Hills Park to mark Holocaust Memorial Day.

I love to hear and share in their remarkable social histories and I benefit so much from their wisdom and thoughts. It is an honour to be able to assist or help in their daily activities at home.


> I love the moments where they give you a special smile or perhaps a little giggle over something silly.





Maintaining Healthy Habits

New Year's resolutions can be a good starting point for making longer term health and lifestyle improvements, but most people who set New Year's resolutions do not stick to them. Reasons for quitting include a lack of time, a lack of support from other people and feeling daunted by unrealistic targets. This tip is aimed at helping you to succeed in maintaining your healthy goals in 2021.

Setting achievable goals

The first thing to consider is whether your New Year's resolutions is achievable and realistic. Often, goals are unachievable because they are too difficult, or they do not allow enough time for you to make gradual changes. There is nothing wrong with aiming high and being ambitious, but it is important that your goal is not too difficult or time-consuming as this could leave you feeling daunted. When setting a goal, ask yourself the following questions:

- Is the goal too ambitious?
- · Is the timeframe for the goal realistic?



- · What specific changes do I need to make to achieve my goal?
- · Can I fit my new healthy behaviour around my other commitments?

Break down your goal

Breaking large goals down into smaller goals can make them feel more achievable and less daunting. For example, if you are aiming to lose weight, the NHS recommends that you aim to lose around 1 to 2lbs (0.5 to 1kg) a week. You should be able to achieve this by cutting down your calorie intake by about 500 to 600 calories each day. It might take you longer than you originally planned to lose the weight, but you are more likely to stick to it and not give

Plan for success

Make a plan of how you will achieve your goal and what changes you will make to ensure you stick to it. Don't expect immediate results

The effects of your New Year's resolution may take time to appear. Try to be patient and don't expect the results from just one or two weeks of dieting to show on the weighing scales, as it may take longer.

Involving other people

A really good way to motivate you to stick to your goal is to involve other people. If you know someone who has a similar goal to yours, try to involve them as a "buddy" to provide mutual support for each other. They may even be able to push you a little bit harder, helping you to achieve your goals and resolutions sooner. You can also look for groups on social media who share your goal.

Do not beat yourself up

If you miss a fitness session, have an alcoholic drink, cigarette or bar of chocolate, try not to feel guilty about it. Think about what might have triggered the deviation from your goal and try to avoid it in future. Forgive yourself and aim to get back to achieving your goal as soon as possible.

Make changes that will last long term

On average, it takes between 21 and 28 days for something to become a long-term habit. Make goals that you want to be able to stick to long term, such as improving your overall fitness, stopping smoking or maintaining your weight. in the garden



By now many of us are ready to 'climb the walls' after our prolonged lockdown and the usual restrictions that winter can place upon us due to shorter days and inclement weather. However, there are some nice little gardening activities we can do indoors and these can be remarkably therapeutic.

So why not crack open a window to let in a little fresh air, spread an old sheet or a plastic tarp on the floor and grab a bag of potting soil ready to do a spot of planting for the 'inside garden'?

There are even special led lit propagators available online that lengthen the days for your plants with low energy use too.

We can grow fresh produce and herbs—or really any other plants that enjoy roughly the same level of warmth as do if we are growing indoors. All you need to get started is a few pots, soil, and some fertilizer.

Quick and Easy Micro Greens

Why not start by growing microgreens? You can literally use an old casserole dish, soil, and some vegetable seeds - any variety will work, with beets, peas, and radishes a popular choice. Plant the seeds in a thin layer of soil, then place the dish in a warm, humid location until they germinate. When the little plants sprout, just water, harvest, and repeat! It's a great idea for kids too and something to focus on each day as they tend to them keeping them correctly watered.

Japanese style Bulb Planting

A Japanese moss garden can be a perfect spring centrepiece for your kitchen table or living room display area. Called kokedama, these beautiful arrangements are basically a bulb wrapped in a piece of sheet moss and secured with twine. You can use a spring bulb such as a tulip or daffodil. Or jazz it up a bit more by using the ball to hold an orchid, fern, or fun succulent variety.

Total Regrow (they'll be back!)

While some plants seem to want to deny us a second chance of growing them, other ones will do anything to keep on growing. If you take a look there are several items in your fridge that will keep growing if given the opportunity!

A lot of vegetable scraps will regrow roots and keep on flourishing if planted, allowing you to get another crop from them. One of the most common vegetables for this project is romaine lettuce. Here's what to do: just give the butt a few inches of water, and it will start sprouting new leaves in a matter of days! And you can also do this with celery, bok choy,

These veggies can all grow back quickly. Now, if you're in it for the long haul, you can regrow potatoes, onions, and even pineapples believe it or not! Why not try it an prove it to yourself? It's a bit of fun and you can eat your rewards.

The Vertical Indoor Gardener

If you are you running out of surfaces to put your new houseplants you could also just create a vertical garden. Items like cut down wooden

ladders, pallets, and pipes can all be used to create vertical plant displays, helping you pack even more greenery into your home. Whilst you may have seen these outdoors they are a perfectly good way to grow the appropriate types of plants indoors as well.

Herbilicious

Try starting an herb garden on your kitchen sill, or see if you can get some seeds to germinate from a regular fruit such as an apple.

A good way to get started is using plain old paper kitchen towel. Simply wrap a few of your chosen seeds in a damp paper towel and place it inside a sealed plastic bag. Put the bag in a dark, warm place and check on it every few days, dampening the paper towel as needed A small fine water mister is perfect for this as it doesn't saturate your seeds). Try apple, lemon, avocado or even an orange. When it sprouts keep it going and eventually you can pot it into a larger container up until it's ready to be acclimatised to the outdoors - what an achievement and something defiant about it amidst our woes!

This month:

Don't forget to order your seeds and bulbs for the upcoming planting season: it's something to look forward to and enjoy doing whilst at home more than usual.

Scarify the lawn on dry days and aerate it if you can with a spiked roller to keep oxygen flowing to the roots of the grass.

Clean your old pots with disinfectant, ready to use in the spring.

Cut back old woody stems from last years Perennials. This is to prevent pests and diseases hiding in the decaying leaves and stems.

Perfect Love:


WHEN HARRY MET SALLY (d. Rob Reiner,

dads in lockdown

Are Dads going to pull their weight on home schooling this time round?

As mums and dads return to home schooling, will the burden fall more equally this time round?

It turned out that mothers were picking up almost all the home teaching burden during the first schools lockdown, with just 11.8 percent of fathers taking the lead on helping their children keep up to speed.

That was the shock finding from a survey of hundreds of parents of primary school-aged children carried out by leading education resources and lesson plan experts PlanBee.

PlanBee's Oli Ryan, a former primary school teacher, said: 'We know that not all families are willing or able to help their children with home learning, but we were amazed to find that there was such a huge gender disparity in terms of who was taking up the teaching mantle.'

who was taking up the teaching mantle.'
He continued: 'The vast majority of primary school workforce are women, but we still find it surprising that when it comes to home teaching Dads appear to be doing so little. If it's a sign that teaching young children is considered to be "women's work", it's pretty alarming.'

And parents – the vast majority, women – were allocating significant parts of their day to home schooling, with over a quarter (27.7 percent) spending more than four hours a day on it

Now, many parents are reporting that because schools have had time to prepare their home schooling lessons, the quality is much improved. In March, an extremely limited number of subjects were being sent to pupils at home by their schools. Nearly all respondents said they had received work in maths (93.04 percent) and English (92.17 percent), with science in third place at just 38.26 percent.

Fitting in home schooling with other work and other commitments was the top challenge for parents, with over a third (35.29) per cent citing it. Keeping their children engaged with learning was second biggest bugbear, at 31.09 percent.

And just 10.92 percent said they were loving home-schooling their children!

Nearly 40 percent of the respondents were primary school teachers as well as parents. And home-schooling was having a big impact on parents' perception of teaching, with nearly one-third (33.6 percent) saying it had altered their attitude.

Parents have now deluged schools inspectorate Ofsted with emails and Tweets praising teachers and school staff for their work during the pandemic citing how quickly schools had set up work on short notice following the last-minute lockdown.

One respondent to the PlanBee survey remarked: 'Trying to get children engaged to learn is very hard! I know it's a challenging time, but my Year 4 struggles to engage if he doesn't like the subject and I can see how that would translate in the classroom! Hats off to all teachers!'

A teacher-parent said that home-schooling was quite different from work: 'I am a teacher but it's different when trying to teach your own!!'

And for teacher-parents, the challenges were particularly marked: 'I now have to teach the children in my class remotely as well as home school my own child. I respect myself and my colleagues a lot more.'

Another said: 'Although I work in nurseries and I'm qualified as a teaching assistant, I don't think I realised just how much work (and patience) goes into teaching.'

Mr Ryan said: 'It's great that so many parents are showing their appreciation for teachers by writing to Ofsted. As to whether Dads will do their fair share of home schooling remains to be seen!'

Meet locals that have been making a difference in our area

"Making sure we are here for years to come" charity supporting Nottingham patients appeals for support as

it approaches its fifth birthday...

January 2021: The duo behind award winning cancer support charity **The Lewis Foundation** are using this year's Covid lockdown to focus on planning for the future and supporting more patients than ever before.

Lorraine and Lee Lewis officially launched their charity in April 2016, with the duo sourcing, packaging and hand delivering free gifts and support packs, called 'Bags of Hope' to adult cancer patients in Nottingham's City Hospital, Queens Medical Centre & Sherwood Forest Hospitals – and other hospitals across the UK. These are items they might find difficult to buy themselves or simply cannot afford.

Now, as the charity's fifth birthday approaches, the couple are focusing on appealing for more support and reducing their charity's costs – which include paying for monthly storage and financing their delivery van and petrol costs.

Lorraine explained: "Hospital can be a sad, frightening, and lonely experience for cancer patients – especially during COVID. Since we launched, we have distributed more than 63,000 gift packs, which we call 'Bags of Hope', to 10 hospitals in Luton, Milton Keynes, Nottingham and Northamptonshire.

"Our focus this year is on sustainability - making sure we are here for years to come."

For this reason, Lorraine and Lee are now appealing for support from local businesses to cover costs such as:



• Website design support – the charity created its own website five years ago and is now looking to create a clean, slicker one – less words, and an easy user journey. All the content is written, and photos gathered. A new website is now top of the wish list.



• Storage – the charity needs circa 1,500sq ft of storage (for donations, gift packs, its marquee, and a space for volunteers to make up the packs) and it must have its own secure entrance. Currently they pay more than £900/month. Can anyone help?



• A contribution towards its van and insurance £550/month. The van is proving increasingly essential as the duo now deliver packs and visit patients across the country.

In exchange for all donations and offers of help, The Lewis Foundation is pledging to thank all supporters by writing press releases, including company logos on their website, writing blogs, running social media campaigns and much more.

Lee explained: "When we first launched The Lewis Foundation, we had no idea how big we would become, how many people would need us and how much positive reactions we would have, not just from patients and their families, but also from the Charity Commission, and our local communities. We want to keep growing and to continue helping more people. More importantly we want to make sure we are future-proof and are here for many, many years to come. That is why we are making this appeal. "

The Lewis Foundation was initially inspired by Lee's mum, who underwent years of treatment before finally being declared cancer free in 2016. Lee and wife Lorraine recognised a need for patient support, hence the launch of their charity which has won many accolades ... including, in 2020, a highly prestigious British Citizen Award, 'Rising Star' at the East Midlands Charity Awards and Points of Light award, awarded by Prime Minister Boris Johnson.




