

COP a look: how to involve youngsters in the UN climate change conference

As world leaders converge on Glasgow, families and schools should grab the opportunity to involve youngsters in sustainable ways in which to battle climate change. Former primary school teacher Catherine Lynch of education resource experts PlanBee has some great ideas.

Ways to set the ball rolling...

1. Involve children in helping to plan how the school can be more

The more involved everyone is, the more invested they will be in achieving meaningful results. Let the children help to form the plan and let them be advocates for it. Create an eco council and let them be part of the decision-making process.

2. Switch to eco-friendly options for school supplies

Pick eco-friendly cleaning products, choose sustainable stationery supplies and do what you can to



3. Reduce waste

Instead of giving out brand new books each year, use workbooks and reading records until they are finished.

Think about what happens to left-over food. Rather than throwing food in the bin, donate what you can to local families or food banks and compost the rest. Buy milk in large bottles (not individual cartons). You'll produce less food waste, less plastic waste and children have the opportunity to wash up the reusable cups.

4. Reduce single-use plastic

Collect all the single-use plastic used in school in one week and share it in an assembly or a staff meeting. Think about the changes you can make to reduce the amount of plastic. This might mean switching suppliers, or buying reusable options, for example, whiteboard pens that

5. Get food from a local supplier

Where could be more local than your own playground? Grow the food you can and teach children about where their food comes from. Look at local suppliers for the rest of the food. You'll be helping local producers, reducing food miles and almost certainly getting better quality produce.

6. Uniform

Hold a uniform swap shop or a second-hand uniform sale to help to give school uniforms a second life. Provide the option for new uniforms to be bought ethically. Look at your current supplier and decide if there is a more sustainable option you could offer to parents.

Encourage children to walk to school and help them understand the reason this is important. Talk to them about the benefits of exercise and the clearer air. If they can't walk the whole way to school, encourage them to walk part of the way.

8. Make a home for wildlife

Create an area in the school grounds that is biodiverse. Grow plants from seeds, make a pond, make bird feeders, make bug hotels. Give the children the chance to slow down and get to know nature. When you've created a home for wildlife in the school, have a look around your local area and see if (subject to permission) there is a place your students could develop.

Go on litter picking trips in your school ground and in your local area. Help to reduce the litter that ends up in waterways. Explain to the children how to litter pick safely and why this is such an important job.

10. Achieve Eco-School status

The Eco Schools Green Flag Award is a great way to get some inspiration, and recognition, for your hard work in becoming an eco school.







beeston film festival





November brings the first international short films night to the Arc Beeston. Beeston Film Festival presents a selection of the best of 2021 festival. The pandemic prevented in person screenings so we are overjoyed to share a collection of spectacular horror films to add to the halloween season. Films from the USA, Italy, England, Iran, France, Germany, and Spain will be seen for the first time on a Beeston big screen.

Included are the Horror B'Oscar winners for the past two years. "Seance" (winner 2020 from Germany) sees mentalist Erik Svenson and his medium Henriette Brandt summon ghosts for private and social occasions, but tonight's show doesn't go to plan. All of a sudden the harmless trick show disturbs a presence in this strange place.

Set very much in the real world is the 2021 Horror B'Oscar Winner, "Loculus". In an Iranian cemetery the morgue power system breaks down, and everyone has to bury the bodies; meanwhile, a ten-yearold boy does not want to bury his mother's body Amir Rooini's vision encapsulates the horror of heartbreak.

On the 29th November we welcome back our partner festival, Everyday Arias, for a return visit to Beeston. Everyday Arias film festival specialises in opera and world theatre equivalents such as Chinese opera, Noh, Kathakali etc.

The 2021 programme once again delivers a kaleidoscopic vision. Leading the way is the super cool, "The Stag Hunt". This modern satire on aristocracy, competition and extinction, draws from a sixteenth century musical curiosity about a king killing for sport, noble born killers if you like. British vocal ensemble I Fagiolini sings



Janequin's La chasse (1537), complete with hunting sound effects, and plays a royal family determined to reign supreme.

"Che si può fare?" counterpoints beautiful cinematography capturing America urban landscape against a fragile brocade of sound. The film

transforms a baroque classic by female baroque composer, Barbara Strozzi, into a timely narrative with themes of isolation and vulnerability.

Whilst "The Children & The Wolf", a dramatic Palestinian film, follows a young boy, deprived of his innocence upon realizing

his role model is being consumed by a tragedy. Now he must decide whether to confront his concerns or give into social state of affairs. Modern opera does not shy away from tough subjects.

So November is a groundbreaking month for both Beeston Film Festival and the Arc cinema. We look forward to seeing you there too.





There is a an organisation called the The Long Now Foundation which

aims to foster a more long term approach to thinking about the future. Established in 1996 it went on to develop an intriguing mechanical clock which you can look up at www.longnow.org. Imagine we could all have something that stayed with us and grew as we grew, changing as the years go by. An accompanying life that needed us and reminded us of the 'long now'.

This is where we might venture into the beautiful world of miniature trees and shrubs... or Bonsai as we know it.

This originally Japanese art has been around for thousands of years and is available to anyone, even a flat dweller with no garden as such.

STARTING ON YOUR JOURNEY

Start with a sapling to speed up the initial process. Saplings are the perfect size for bonsai and you're already years ahead of schedule compared to starting a tree from a seed. Bonsai trees are just normal trees that are pruned and trained to remain small. That means you can choose just about any tree variety to bonsai.

Some preferred bonsai tree species include junipers, pines, Japanese maples, and Chinese elms. The sapling you choose should be proportionally appropriate for bonsai. An ideal tree will have small leaves or needles and the trunk should be naturally tapered, in other words, the trunk should be wider on the bottom and gradually become narrower on the top. Avoid choosing a sapling with large leaves or a weak trunk. Ideally, the sapling you choose should already have a natural, mature appearance before you start pruning and shaping it.

GROWING

Choose saplings that are growing in a 1-gallon container. Typically, trees of this size will already have a more mature root system and a thicker trunk, two things that take years to properly develop.

There are a few steps to take to prepare a sapling for bonsai. You will start by gently remove the sapling from its original pot (if it was supplied with one) and begin removing excess soil from the roots. Be cautious not to break the main stem.

Before repotting the sapling, you'll need to prune the roots. By pruning the roots, you slow down its growth, so the tree does not quickly outgrow their shallow container. Bonsai trees require some rootwork to live a healthy life in a shallow container. Because of the limited water and nutrients stored in the small pot, roots will continue to grow in search of more. In a shallow pot, a bonsai's roots will grow in one area. It's best to prune roots during the slow growing season, usually in the late fall or early spring. Root pruning can shock a plant so the slow growth season helps reduce the stress on a bonsai tree.

As always, keep learning in the garden and, most of all... Enjoy!





winter shelter



Emmanuel House is delighted to confirm the re-opening of its Winter Shelter. The charity will offer accommodation for up to 22 people per night – ensuring there are fewer people on the streets during the coldest months of the year.

Prior to the pandemic, the Nottingham Winter Shelter, which has been running since 2006, utilised shared spaces, such as church halls, to offer accommodation to people who were rough sleeping each night.

A the peak of the virus and as part of the Government's 'Everyone In' initiative, the Shelter provision was moved to single rooms in local hotels where guests were able to safely self-isolate. The 24 hour wrap-around support this accommodation model offered proved invaluable and a total of 178 people moved into long-term accommodation. This provision came to an end earlier this year, but Covid regulations and restricted numbers have meant that a return to previous locations is no longer feasible.

In order to find a new solution that enables us to continue with the Winter Shelter, accommodation has been offered by The University of Nottingham at a cost-neutral rate. This will allow support work to continue during the day as guests are helped to find work, permanent accommodation and access other services. The Winter Shelter will utilise an empty building on the University Campus. This will be modified with the use of temporary walls and screens, so that each guest has their own space within current guidelines, with additional rooms on a separate floor to be used as isolation rooms if a guest tests positive for Covid-19. The Winter Shelter will offer 24 hour access, so that if there is another lockdown, guests will be able to use their rooms all day.

Denis Tully, CEO at Emmanuel House, said: "The accommodation the University of Nottingham is able to provide enables us to build on the legacy of Everybody In when we moved 179 people into accommodation solutions. I am very grateful to the University for all its support for this vital service as without its collaboration it is likely the service would not have happened this year. It's an exciting time for the project.

"Historically the shelter has been located in a number of different residential areas around the city and has a record of being of the highest standard. This was recognised when it was awarded the Housing Justice gold standard quality mark."

The Nottingham Winter Shelter serves the needs of homeless and vulnerable people during the coldest months of the season. We provide them with shelter, acceptance, physical and emotional support, and encouragement in making positive changes in their lives. Anyone over the age of 18 can access the services regardless of their personal characteristics or cultural identity.

Ashley Roberts, Head of Campus Services, is leading the project. He said: "By supporting this work, up to 22 people will be off the streets and in a warm and safe location each night.

"We've already been able to offer donations of clothes and other items and the charity is grateful to those who might also be able to offer their time to volunteer to support them. We're delighted that our Asymptomatic Testing Service can also support their work and help keep everyone safe. It shows all aspects of the university coming together to make a really positive difference to people's lives."

The Nottingham Winter Shelter provides a lifeline for the most vulnerable people in our society, giving them a safe space where they can find welcome, warmth and rest, food and drink and support and advice that can help them move away from homelessness to a brighter future. If the Winter Shelter is unable to operate, many needy people will be at risk, this year even more than usual. Homeless people face not only the usual dangers from cold and wet weather, but also additional dangers of catching and spreading Covid-19 whilst sleeping rough or sofa surfing and unable to readily access healthcare. 


