



black history month



A UK exhibition created with the help of Nottingham's Caribbean elders

Museumand, The National Caribbean Heritage Museum is based right here in Nottingham, but as a museum "without walls" it shares the story of Caribbean history, heritage and culture around the UK.

Museumand launched their book, "70 Objeks & Tings – Celebrating 70 Years of Caribbeans in the UK", last year, with the pandemic meaning they had to launch it online. Now, with pandemic restrictions lifted, the museum have been able to launch their book in style, with a printed version of the book and an installation-exhibition to bring each chapter to life.

The "70 Objeks & Tings – Celebrating 70+ Years of Caribbeans in the UK" installation-exhibition is currently on display at the Streetlife Museum in Hull, giving visitors the chance to get up close and personal with some of the objeks & tings featured in the book.

Both the book and the installation-exhibition have been created by Museumand with the help of Caribbean elders living right here in Nottingham. Museumand interviewed 184 Caribbean elders and asked them to share their precious stories through everyday objects and experiences – the tangible objeks and intangible tings that are familiar to both island life and British life, together with a generous flavour of Caribbean sayings, riddles and songs!

One of those contributors with an incredible story to tell is Chelsie Wint who came to England from Jamaica in 1964 to pursue a career in nursing. Chelsie trained as a nurse specialising in ear, nose and throat care and worked on night duty for 20 years, including 16 years in charge of the ward. A mother of six, Chelsie became a member of the Assemblies of the First Born Church in Nottingham and helped lead the church's Young People Group. At the age of 66, Chelsie studied for a Certificate of Intercultural Theology at the University of Nottingham. Now, aged 85 with 15 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren, Chelsie is an active member of her GP practice User Group, still caring for others. She continues her spiritual ministry as a volunteer visitor, at nursing homes and prisons.

Another interviewee is Madge Spencer, who may be familiar to some Breeze readers. Madge came to the UK from Jamaica and moved to Nottingham. A trained potter, Madge taught pottery in schools before setting up her own studio. Madge still gives talks and pottery demonstrations in libraries and schools and is also a volunteer visitor at hospitals and prisons. She has been delighting audiences of all ages and ethnicities at Nottinghamshire heritage venues for over a decade, telling Caribbean folk tales.

Museumand also interviewed Caribbeans born in Britain, including Lenny Bedward, who created his first sound system with his brother, aged just 14, to bring the music of the Caribbean to Nottingham. Over 45 years on, the Bedward brothers are still playing music.

cycle of life....

From simple commuter styles to off road MTB's, cycles have never been more popular, and with the latest electric models we don't have to start off the hard way when taking to two wheels...

"If only cycling was a bit easier I'd use it to go to work" Is this you as you as you head out to work in your car on that all too short journey? Or "I used to love cycling when I was younger but I don't think my joints could stand it now!" Sound familiar?

These sentiments are amongst the most commonly used reasons/excuses people give for not cycling, probably along with "I can't go around wearing Lycra tights!". Fortunately things have changed dramatically for the better and easier on two wheels.

Bikes are like clothes

The reason we say this is because bikes are a semi-bespoke item: they need to fit nicely. And when they do you start off not noticing anything about them in particular. When you just grab any old bike (that's 'about the right size') it will most likely feel somewhat 'odd' in some way or other - something noy quite right in the riding position, the feel of the steering as you corner or awkward (to you) gears perhaps.

The frame size being wrong can mean an overstretched back and the pedals in the wrong place for your posture resulting in leg strain.

Electric Cycles the big development in commuting

With sales expected to boom in the next few years in the UK, these types of cycles are already massive in Europe. Normally taking about three hours to fully charge, these bikes give the rider the 'extra push' many of us feel we may need when getting a bit tired on the way home from work or a longer journey. It's the commute that many have been concerned about with Covid as they don't want to be pushed up against lots of people on buses and trams.

With swish looking new saddle bags these also allow you to carry your laptop and offfice work to and from home.

They have been made possible by the availability not only of more powerful but lighter batteries but newer and much stronger motors and can give up to 100 miles on a single charge! The battery is simply detached and charged up like a laptop so your bike stays outside the living room etc. Alternatively just pull up and charge it in the garage or from an ordinary weatherproof outside plug in point.

Whilst there are many designs and makes of electric bikes they are not all equal and the key point here is the battery/motor make and set up. Broadly speaking a 'hub motor' is the better option and brands such as Bosch (but not exclusively) deliver significantly better push when you really need it. You still get the physical and mental health benefits of gentle excercise but without the strain on an e-bike. Furthermore you can use them for leisure and more practical purposes as they make a quiet and comfortable ride in the countryside a delight.

A bike for the purpose

Types of bikes vary but a common type today is the 'hybrid' bike. These combine the road use characteristics needed for a commute but also are rugged enough to go off road on tracks and trails. 'Cyclo-Cross' is another sub-type and are lighter/quicker too with similar strength. Both types are better at dealing with potholes etc when on the road. They have a good range of gearing to cover steeper climbs off road (or on if you are feeling tired that day!) but can extend to speed you onwards when the path is smooth and you have a good run going.

We will also briefly mention modern folding cycles as well because they are a much more modern and lightweight successor to those old fashioned small wheeled bikes we sometimes saw leaving the train station years ago. Bestowed with clever folding mechanisms and all alloy frame and wheels these interesting

Are your windows getting in the way of a better view? It might be time to look at the glass that's standing between you and the outside...

uPVC frames last for decades and that is their central quality for homeowners with their low maintenance. 



gardening...

keeping it

local

The Autumn now beckons and we start to fiddle with the settings on our central heating. But what about the animals that live in and around our garden?

Let's take a look at our garden foragers.

As we live in the various parts of the cityscape rather than in the countryside it's interesting to see how wildlife has adapted to our artificial environment. What constitutes an artificial environment as different to a natural one anyway?

An artificial ecosystem is one made by man to mimic a naturally-occurring ecosystem - a delverate attempt to recreate that which is held to be good for biodiversity and life for animals of differing types and sizes - even the bacterial life that we don't see.

It is always worth taking a look at your garden, especially as we start to enter winter, and asking yourself: 'what can I do to make my garden more friendly, more responsive to the needs of nature'?

THINGS YOU CAN DO TO HELP NATURE THIS AUTUMN

Build a log pile to encourage biodiversity - it's the ideal habitat for small mammals, amphibians and all manner of insects.

Make a tepee-shaped logpile to attract hedgehogs. Remember to check for wildlife before lighting a bonfire.

If you have a fence, remove a small section - make the hole no bigger than a CD case to allow hedgehogs and frogs into your plot.

Bumblee home for the winter: Take a clay pot, fill with leaves, straw and a little cotton wool and place upside down in a sheltered spot. A bumblebee prospecting for an over-wintering nest may well take up residence.

Leave some for the animals: Why not leave a few hanging fruits for the birds, hedgehogs and other animals for instance?

PLANT A TREE

What type of young tree to buy: Trees can be purchased either in either a container or as bare-rooted plants. Either way you should look for well-developed fibrous roots. With container grown trees, check that it's roots aren't congested and choose younger trees of around one to three years old which tend to get established more rapidly. Obviously, avoid plants that show any sign of disease.

Soak the roots before planting - bare-root trees can be planted in late autumn or early winter because this is when the tree is in its dormant stage.

Don't plant if there's a frost, just place the roots into moist soil until conditions improve (we do usually have some milder spells during early winter despite the media pundits telling us how bad the winters are becoming here in the UK!). Container grown trees can be planted at any time of year (frost or soil too dry/wet excepted).

Locating a spot for your tree:

Place your tree in a sunny and sheltered position to give the most time your tree has to grow, especially whilst young and getting established. Dig a hole one third wider than it's roots (and the same depth) as the tree's roots, firming the bottom of the hole into a slight mound. Insert a support stake and the tree. Fill it back in with soil and mound towards the base of the tree attaching it to the stake with a soft rubber loop (these can be bought from any garden suppliers).

If you're growing your tree in a container then half fill a large tub with your soil-based potting compost and place your tree on top. Fill the tub in with more soil to the base of the tree and water well. Feed regularly to keep it growing nicely to maturity.

As always, keep positive and learning whilst in the garden - look for signs of disease in your plants and manage those. Most of all... *Enjoy!*






