

local

We are a social enterprise started by students at the University of Nottingham, selling surplus food at greatly reduced prices through our low-cost social supermarket in Sneinton, Nottingham. We also act as an intermediary between supermarkets, wholesalers, charities and the people of Nottingham to redistribute food.

Food waste shouldn't coexist with people struggling to afford nutritious food. We tackle this imbalance directly, redirecting food that is perfectly fit for consumption but would otherwise go to waste.

Between first opening in 2017 and now, we have seen great progression in our pursuit to reduce food waste from going to landfill, in addition to providing affordable food to our community. We have significantly expanded our redistribution network, partnering with more school breakfast clubs, food banks and other local organisations than ever before.

Our latest project 'Foodprint on Wheels', aims to bring affordable, surplus food to the Nottingham community with our newly renovated van, thanks to the support of the National Lottery Community Fund, and funding from alumni and friends of the University of Nottingham via Cascade.

Another exciting project our team have been working on is 'Dried Apple Smiles'. Our dried apples are baked and prepared by the Open Wings organisation that provides support to adults with learning difficulties. We then redistribute our dried apples to school breakfast clubs, helping children to get the most nutrition out of their school breakfast meals.

Reduce Food Waste

The UK throws away enough food to fill the Royal Albert Holl every single day, 60% of which is still fit for human consumption. This equates to 6 million tonnes of edible food per year.



Encourage Healthy Eating

it is thought that 3.7 million children in the UK can't afford a healthy, balanced diet, with more nutritious foods such as fruit and veg often being more expensive.



Combat Household Food Insecurity

In the UK, over I/10 adults and almost 1/4 parents with children aged under 18 have skipped meals because of a lack of money.

Intercept

We collect from numerous partners all over the city, intercepting perfectly edible food before it is tossed into landfill. We even collect surplus food from the partners we deliver to when they can't use it themselves.



Redistribute

We weigh and sort the collections at our shop and redistribute it for free to those who need it most. The surplus that can't be redistributed to food banks, community eating projects, or schools stays with us.



Sell

We sell the remaining surplus food in Nottingham's first social supermarket as cheaply as is sustainably possible, subsidising fruit and vegetables in particular to make healthy eating as affordable as possible.

Living with any condition can be daunting.

Meet and share experiences with our locals living with Parkinson's.

On July 17th Janet Barnes from Beeston Rylands alongside her friend Caroline and boxing coaches Maxine and Christian raised £4,300 for Parkinson's UK.

The team boxed for 12 hours non stop at the Mixed Martial Arts Gym in Sutton-in-Ashfield. The gym holds two weekly boxing training sessions specifically aimed at helping those suffering from Parkinson's, and many of the regulars joined in the 12 hour boxing challenge.

Janet who was diagnosed with Parkinson's three years ago at the age of 47 said "it was a fantastic day, full of positivity and really celebrated what people with Parkinson's can do rather than what they can't"

On 17th February 2018 the first "Drop-In" Café was opened at the Parish Hall of The Assumption RC Church in Beeston. It was opened by members of the local support group of Parkinson's UK, the national charity for people who are living with Parkinson's, their family and carers. We put up adverts all over Broxtowe and distributed information letters to GP Practices.

On that first Drop-In morning, we had 21 people who all had Parkinson's or lived with someone who did. They were all keen to talk about their experiences and listen to others. At the last Drop-In before Covid interrupted us in March 2020, we had a visit from our new MP, Darren Henry.

There are approximately 60-100 people in Broxtowe living with Parkinson's today. About a dozen people would have been diagnosed since we last met 18 months ago. None of these have had access to the information, booklets and other resources produced by Parkinson's UK. Having the right information, the correct medication for the stage of your condition, and the positive frame of mind that can come from meeting others who share your experiences can help you improve the management of your Parkinson's. 

beeston film festival



The team worked hard to prepare our biggest festival once again online, putting all of the amazing films

submitted to the festival onto one program. It was an amazing effort to make sure all 19 sessions aired as planned. Filmmaker support during on the on-going pandemic we awesome.

This year, much coveted 'Best in Festival B'Oscar went to Marleen Valien, a Berlin Film Student, for 'A Small Cut'. A hilarious, and incredibly crafted period film about an uptight Jewish finance director of a lavish Baroque court who unexpectedly finds himself forced to convince his hot-headed young ruler to get a circumcision. A classic bold and striking film by a filmmaker determined to make an impact. Original and challenging films is the hallmark of a great festival.

New to this year's festival is the 'Pride' category, uplifting queer voices and giving a platform to present stories of love, struggle, or both. The film industry is crucial in normalizing same sex love. We have seen some positive steps, such as Barry Jenkins' Moonlight winning Best Picture at the Oscars in 2017, Céline Sciamma's Portrait of a Lady on Fire becoming an instant classic recently or Cate Blanchett delivering an acclaimed performance in Carol.

The winner of the inaugural Pride B'Oscar, Manchester Pride Parade: The Movie, offers a masterfully crafted look at the legal and cultural history of LGBTQ+ from the past century in Britain. Showing the arduous fight towards equality helps everyone understand, especially those outside of the queer community, just how hard people had to fight to simply not be arrested for loving a person of the same sex. The second half of the film features people from right now, representing the community and celebrating it at least in this symbolic way.

If 2021 was great, then 2022 will be fantastic as we are delighted to be partnering with the wonderful Arc Cinema. As the festival hub it will provide a state of the art cinema to showcase the festival's international short films.



The 'Perennial problem'... or what to do now the garden is starting to show obvious signs that shorter days are closer and temperatures are cooling.

When annual flowering plants start to get exhausted your garden will start to look a little wilted too - if you don't have something ready to fill their role!

Interest in the winter may come from flowers, scent, berries, coloured stems or dramatic evergreen foliage. Plants with fragrance are best appreciated when planted by doorways or entrances in regular winter use. By using containers you can move these plants into a good visible position in winter and then away during summer when they may not look so good.

A great way of growing many of these plants is to use loam-based compost, such as John Innes No 2. Don't forget that flowering of shrubs can be sporadic over several weeks or months, depending on the severity of the winter so try to be patient and understanding - these are living things!

A nice example is Photinia: a tough, versatile shrub. The 'Red Robin' variety has glossy leaves which are bright red when young, gradually changing to bronze-green through to deep green. Photinia grows well in sunny borders, as specimen shrubs in large patio containers.

If you choose a climbing plant such as Clematis don't forget to factor in some sort of structure for it to attach to - a trellis or similar. This can be attached to a wooden tub so that you can move it around despite of being a climber.

Plan ahead and plant some hardy annuals ready for next year: Some good examples are Achillea 'Coronation Gold' which has vertical stems and flat horizontal flowerheads with a lovely combination of flower and foliage colour. Another good one is Monkshood and is uncommon for bringing a rich lavender-blue colouring to the autumn garden which is more often filled with orange and rusty shades so it's a nice colour contrast.

Winter is not to be dreaded when it comes to the garden - just use your knowledge and let nature be your guide - after all she has been used to many more winters than you have!

As always, keep learning, get out in the garden whenever you can and most of all.... Enjoy!



Following the success of the Olympic Winner, a new venture is all set for a skatepark at Central Avenue, Beeston with Betongpark and Skate Nottingham...

Millions watched Sky Brown win Bronze in Tokyo, alongside Japan's Yosozumi Sakura's Gold and Hiraki Kokona's Silver medals. As well as witnessing the skaters' physical achievements, this huge global audience also witnessed the friendship, warmth and camaraderie inherent to skateboarding culture.

Sky Brown became Britain's youngest ever summer Olympian, at aged just 13, and now all eyes are on Paris 2024, in which skateboarding will again feature.

Beeston To benefit

However, Beeston has not yet benefited from the proliferation of high quality, bespoke concrete skateboarding facilities that have appeared across the UK over the last 15 years. The site in Beeston Fields, close to Central Avenue, was in particular need of attention, as the outdated modular forms had become almost completely unused by skateboarders and other wheeled sports practitioners.

Councillor Steve Carr, Deputy Leader of Broxtowe Borough Council, said: "I am very happy to support this exciting project. It will give young people something extra to do and who knows, given the success of Sky Brown, there may be a budding Olympic skateboarder in Beeston.'


Collaboration and Cooperation

With support from Habito Mortgages, alongside grant funding from UK Research and Innovation (UKRI), Nottinghamshire County Council and local Councilors, social enterprise Skate Nottingham are working with the Beeston Civic Society, Beeston Street Art and Broxtowe Borough Council to enlist the expertise of Betongpark to create new concrete forms at the Beeston fields site, with local young people and adults working with them to learn new trade and professional skills.

Beeston Civic Society and Beeston Street Art had worked together with Skate Nottingham to identify potential sites for a 'Build it Yourself' project that would enable local people to volunteer under the supervision of leading experts to transform a space at a fraction of the cost of a build undertaken entirely by a commercial provider - also ensuring participants learn transferable and specialist trade skills as they work together to create a facility they can truly call their own. Broxtowe Borough Council kindly agreed to the project taking place at the site at Central Avenue and arranged for the old forms to be removed and the riding surface to be repaired with fresh tarmac, ready for the new elements to be created.

International Input

Betongpark are a Norwegian skatepark design and construction firm with a studio and build team in the UK and are leading the industry in adopting sustainable techniques, including use of low energy, low noise and low emissions equipment and in collaborating with community groups. Earlier this summer, they worked with Hackney Bumps community group to finish the renovation of the previously dilapidated 1980s concrete skatepark. building on work that had previously been undertaken by volunteers. They are also working with Skate Nottingham to advise the contractors working on behalf of Nottingham City Council on how to achieve a high quality 'skate friendly' public space at Sussex Street, near Broadmarsh, which will be the second of its kind in England.

Sherwood Forest Trust Plants 'Trees for the Future'

The Sherwood Forest Trust, a local charity established over 25 years ago, is working with the 'Miner2Major' Landscape Partnership Scheme to plant 10 'Heritage Trees' - celebrating the special place that trees play in the landscape and history of the Sherwood Forest area.

In July, the Trust was at Feel Good Gardens CIC, a community garden at Forestry Holdings next door to Sherwood Pines, hosting their third event as part of the Heritage Trees project.

Members of Feel Good Gardens – who carry out gardening at the site for therapeutic and wellbeing purposes - helped to plant 6 espalier apple trees, as well as a memorial tree. Members and volunteers grow their own fruit and vegetables on site, which they then go on to use in group cooking sessions and shared meals. So as well as being good news for wildlife and birds, the planting of these apple trees will provide tasty benefits for the future. Amy Chandler, community ranger for Forestry England, attended the event and gave a

Gary Joynt from Major Oak Heritage Crafts gave members green woodworking demonstrations and led 'have-a-go' sessions. Gary said, "I loved every minute and I was inspired by the great work going on at Feel Good Gardens and the lovely folks who attended. Hats off to the Sherwood Forest Trust for organising this event and raising awareness of how important trees are to our heritage, wildlife and local landscape."

The Sherwood Forest Trust hope that the event might become a joint annual event at Feel Good Gardens, working with members and the local community to emphasise the importance of trees and community co-operation for the future of Sherwood Forest.






