It's December, and to many of us that means Christmas, Hanukkah or Yule, a time of celebration and joy.

We need joy right now. Times are tough, and with the cold winter now here it can be easy to feel the gloom pressing in. But let's not forget that we have each other, that we can support and uplift the people around us in a hundred little ways every day. It's a sense of community that gets people through hard times, and we at the Beeston Film Festival are proud to be part of Beeston's community.

We're nearly closed for submissions now, having had nearly 700 entries at the time of writing. There are all sorts of films to sort through, many of which are full of conflict and drama that reflect the troubled state of the world. But my favourites are often the ones that put a smile on your face and remind you that there is good and beauty in the world after all.

Here are just a few of the uplifting and inspiring submissions we've had:

**Between Wings and Swings** is about a little girl who must learn to let go of things she loves when her friend moves away. It's sweetly charming, 3D animated in a way that suggests the characters are handfelted dolls.

In **Free**, a young refugee in Sicily is caught trying to steal fish from a local market, and a kind stranger comes to her aid. It's a story of compassion, childhood innocence and the importance of helping others.

There's plenty of superheroes in Hollywood films flying around thwarting villains and protecting justice – but who's there to help with kids' problems like lost footballs and family strife? Enter **SuperHero** with a positive message and a surprise twist!

**Dateleap** tackles love in the digital age – a couple trying out a revolutionary virtual reality dating app dance all night in a simulation of the 1930s, but when technological mishaps lead to a misunderstanding, can love prevail?

And finally there's **Empress ClawScream**, a geeky 90s nostalgia-fest in which a young woman must find the strength to stand up to a nerdy bully and declare her love for her best friend, thanks to some mystical help from a flamboyant cartoon villainess she wished into existence. It's as moving as it is silly, and it's very silly!

Happy holidays, everyone!



# the plane tree

keeping it

The Plane Tree on Beeston's High Road has recently arrived in the centre of the community. The perfect place to buy local art and handmade gifts or join an art workshop. However, The Plane Tree loves browsers as well as buyers as the main purpose of the shop is positive social engagement.

The shop has been started by the supported internship team at Nethergate Academy in Nottingham. Having spent twelve years as head of Upper School, Shelly Wood and the team have been driving to create better life chances for young people with additional needs.

"The number of adults with a learning disability who are in employment is below 5% locally." Shelly explained. "Community engagement and being able to contribute positively to society is so important. Without this people are prone to mental health problems and all kinds of social disadvantage."

The Plane Tree is a not for profit, community interest company. It aims to improve this situation through a multi-strand approach.

"Firstly, we offer bespoke training for young adults with special educational needs. The training is linked to their needs and may include developing social skills, community experience, systematic work training, whatever that person needs to move forward towards employability. Beyond this we also have to engage local employers and support them in understanding how a young person with an additional need, might benefit their business. We will work in partnership with any potential employer and offer them free training and support them in taking on an apprentice or part time worker. The aim is that both parties benefit and succeed."

The final strand in improving the life chances of people with additional needs is down to us, the public. The Plane Tree asks that we engage with this community more. That's why they are happy whether you're a buyer or not. There is much misunderstanding about those who are different and a certain unhelpful stigma. Shelly sees The Plane Tree as a way of addressing this "It's important to that those with learning difficulties are seen and recognised as the valuable members of society that they are. The shop will, I hope, do just that"

That intent also answers the question on the origin of the name. Shelly explains "I chose the name as 'The Plane Tree' is a very fitting Aesop's fable: "The travellers sought shade on a hot day under a plane tree. Lying there they considered the tree. 'What use is the plane tree? It has no fruit, no flowers and its leaves just litter the ground' The moral being 'Our greatest assets are easily overlooked".
















# spotted dog art group

# salvation army band

A musical treat awaits the audience on Wednesday, December 21st when a famous Salvation Army band presents a Christmas carol concert at Beeston Methodist Church.

The William Booth Memorial Halls Band will bring its big sound to the landmark building and give people an opportunity to hear their favourite carols played during the 75-minute performance

Bandmaster Richard Ellis said: "We are really looking forward to the concert. During the evening, as part of the programme, we will invite members of the audience to say why a certain carol is their favourite and then we will

The band has a long and distinguished history and is renowned far and wide for its musicianship and Gospel message. It's the fourth oldest Salvation Army Band in the country, having been founded in 1860 when it was known as the Nottingham 1 band.

Under the leadership bandmaster Ralph Bristow from 1951 to 1986, the band played before the Princess Royal at London's Albert Hall, took part in BBC Radio's Sunday Half Hour programme, appeared on Songs of Praise and toured Switzerland and Norway.

The band celebrated its 125th anniversary in 2005. This is their third appearance in Beeston in modern times, having twice played at Wollaton Road Methodist Church in 2006 and 2012.

Entry to the concert, which starts at 7.30pm, is by donation.

Proceeds from the evening will be shared between the band and the Mission Possible Project - a £1.6m redevelopment planned at Beeston Methodist Church in Chilwell Road to enable it to respond better to community needs in the 21st century.

As well as undertaking major improvement



work, the impressive pipe organ, presented to the church when it was built in 1902, will undergo a complete overhaul.

The concert is the latest in a rolling programme of fundraising events and the church is now three quarters of the way towards its £200,000 self-funding target.

#### 10 essential gardening jobs for December

Green fingered Brits are being offered top tips on the gardening jobs they should be doing ahead of Christmas.

The experts at GardeningExpress.co.uk have put together their list of ten gardening tasks to do this December.

While December may be a quieter month for gardeners, there are still plenty of jobs to be getting on with and preparations ahead of 2023.

Among the tasks are putting food out for the birds, protecting pots and plants and looking after the lawn.

Chris Bonnett from GardeningExpress.co.uk said: "December may be a month to kick back and enjoy the festive celebrations but there's still work to be done in the garden.

"It's a good time to get on top of all those jobs you've been putting off like cleaning garden tools and storing away items like hoses and

"Other important jobs include protecting pots and tender plants ahead of cold weather and feeding the birds and other wildlife coming into the

#### Feeding the birds

Stock up on bird seed, hang up your bird feeders and make sure there's plenty of fresh water for any birds visiting your garden over the colder months.

#### **Protecting pots**

If you have terracotta pots in the garden that could crack in freezing weather, wrap them in bubble wrap or put them somewhere warmer. If you have pots dotted around the garden, group them together on a sheltered spot.

#### Protect tender plants

Protect any tender or young plants in the garden. You can surround them with straw to provide a wintery blanket or wrap them in protective fleece. Alternatively, bring the inside away from the harsh weather.

#### Storing garden equipment

Store away your hose to stop it freezing and splitting in the cold weather and give your garden tools a good clean down so they're ready to use in the Spring. If you still have garden furniture out, it's worth storing this away or covering up.

#### **Pruning**

December's a good time to start pruning fruit trees, although avoid touching stone fruits. These are better pruned in the warmer months. Wisteria and Japanese Maples are also worth pruning

#### Harvest winter veg

Harvest any remaining winter veg and store somewhere cool and away from damp to enjoy during the winter.

#### Prepare the soil

Dig over the bare soil if you get a chance and clear away any weeds or debris. This important prep will mean your soil's in the best possible condition when the weather warms up.

#### Take cuttings

Hardwood cuttings are best taken now during the dormant season. Ideal if you want to take cuttings from fruit trees, climbers and shrubs.

#### Look after your lawn

If it's snowy or frosty, avoid walking on your lawn - this can damage the grass. Try and keep it clear of leaves and spike with a fork to improve drainage.




