John Flynn Opticians' new machine, though, builds on this technology to create 4D imagery accurate to just a single micron - one hundredth of the width of a human hair.

The system also uses artificial intelligence to track the exact position of successive scans, overlaying them precisely to check changes over successive months or years. Fast, contact-free and painless, the system can also send images to hospital departments for other clinicians to review in the event of a referral.

"We can use the technology to examine tiny details that help us to detect eye disease at the earliest stages, reducing the risk of sight loss and improving our patients' lives," says Dr Janjua.


Breeze meets local business woman Laura Serrant, whose poem was chosen to accompany a monument to the Windrush generation

Nottingham business woman Laura who's poem was chosen to appear on a new statue to commemorate the Windrush generation has described it as an "absolute honour".

Prof Laura Serrant OBE, who is originally from Nottingham, said: "It's something I never even dreamed of."

The monument, at London's Waterloo Station, celebrates thousands of people who arrived in the UK from Caribbean countries between 1948 and 1971

It depicts a family with suitcases and was revealed to mark Windrush Day.



Prof Serrant, who is employed by Health Education England as regional head of nursing for Yorkshire and the North East, said she had been asked to forward her poem for consideration by the committee behind the monument by Baroness Floella Benjamin.

"I agreed, she submitted it and it was accepted," she said. "It was an absolute honour."

The government gave £1m to fund the statue, which was designed by Basil Watson.

Prof Serrant added: "The national Windrush monument commemorates the bravery of men, women and children from the Caribbean who came in 1948 to help rebuild Britain.

"They came from sunny climes to Britain and they felt they were doing their duty.


"At the time, the Caribbean was part of the British Empire and people felt they were as British as the people who lived here.

"Over 70 years later, we see a national monument recognising their contribution to the nation.

"For me, [I felt] the responsibility to commemorate that generation, who obviously included my own parents, and reflect their contribution and uphold the honour of their fortitude."

Laura joined the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge along with Windrush passengers Alford Gardner and John Richards and children at the unveiling of the National Windrush Monument at Waterloo Station.





### Gadgeteers, Summer Reading Challenge 2022 at Inspire libraries 9th July - 4th September.

Libraries in Nottinghamshire are gearing up for a summer of reading fun, as the Summer Reading Challenge returns with a special science and innovation themed challenge, guaranteed to spark children's curiosity about the world around them.

Produced by The Reading Agency and run in libraries across the country, the Summer Reading Challenge encourages children aged 4 to 11 to read for pleasure over the summer holidays, building reading skills and confidence and helping to prevent the 'dip' in reading skills while children are out of school.

Children read six library books of their choice over the summer, collecting rewards (including smelly stickers) along the way. Every child who completes the challenge will receive a certificate and medal.

Developed in partnership with the Science Museum Group, this year children are invited to join the Gadgeteers on a science filled reading adventure. ### beeston film festival


Bigger, Better, Bolder! By Sam Kurd

Gears are engaging, wheels are in motion, and though I'm not at liberty to gossip about all the great changes we have planned, suffice to say that by the time we arrive at our 10th anniversary, we'll have done our fair share in helping Beeston become the cultural hub it serves to be!

On that note, Festival Director John Currie and Commercial Director Simon Pryce recently hopped across the channel to Cannes – not (just!) to soak up the sun but to network and brainstorm and connect with creatives from all around the world. They came back buzzing with ideas and we're putting them into motion – watch this space for details as we get closer to the Festival weekend...

That weekend looks to be as brilliant as ever, if the quality of submissions is anything to go by. As our selection team beaver away, the cream of the crop is rising to the top and competition is heating up. Here's a sneak peek at some films that may make the cut, though it's early days yet:

Bus Driver is a compelling drama about racial tension and how misconceptions and prejudice can quickly spiral into violence. It's unflinching in its attitude and leaves you wondering how we got to such a bitter and distrustful state of affairs.

Thriller Voices is just as tense, tackling domestic violence and asking if and when a bystander should act to intervene. It's witty and clever too, though, with a killer punchline!

Not My Sister is a tough but tender drama, a look at a three generations of women trying to love each other but bound by secrets and resentment. A strong contender for Best in Festival in my view!

And then there's Hideous, a musical exploration of fear and passion and gay identity. It's slick, stylish and arresting.


I transposed guitar parts and experimented with arrangements until the songs spoke to me. As with my other albums, I recorded and produced it myself at my home studio."
