Christmas at Wollaton will run from Friday 2nd December 2022 until Sunday 1st January 2023 (and will be closed on 5 and 25 December), with pre-bookable slots staggered every 30 minutes.

A major attraction for festive visitors, last year Christmas at Wollaton Hall was attended by 100,000 people, who travelled from across the region and beyond to marvel at the wonderous displays of lights and lasers.

For the first time, organisers of Christmas at Wollaton is award winning team Kilimanjaro who are donating 500 tickets so that charities can enjoy the lights in the first week of opening. 




# beeston film


Animation: A Medium, Not a Genre by Sam Kurd











One of the Beeston Film Festival's most successful categories is Animation. There's a common misconception that 'animated' is a genre in and of itself, synonymous with 'family' or 'for kids'. This couldn't be more wrong!

Animation is a medium, just like live-action, and as such animated films come in many genres. Many of the films that are submitted to the festival under this category would sit just as comfortably in the Drama, Comedy or even Horror category. Animation lets a creator's imagination run wild, painting with a palette they'd never have in live-action without a budget in the high millions.

Here's a few of this year's festival hopefuls in the Animation category:

**My Dear Son** is a touching and emotional story of a mother whose son is different to the other kids. Not wanting him to be ostracised and disadvantaged, she forces him to be something he's not, hoping he'll fit in. Anyone who's struggled with their identity is bound to moved by this one.

On the more abstract end of the scale is **Stay**, which uses the imagery of a game of cats cradle to represent the fabric of a family in turmoil, a daughter whose father is distant and cold. The visuals are rendered beautifully (they're hand-embroidered!) and this one's a real tear-jerker.


On a much darker note, **Wych** is a film that would comfortably slot right into our Horror session. Light on narrative but heavy on oppressive atmosphere, it's a Lynchian nightmare that uses its soundscape expertly to disturb and unnerve. Not for the faint of heart!

The coffee-lovers among us (like me!) may feel called out by Sip, a hilarious Nigerian film about the dangerous relationship between coffee and productivity. Sure, it feels good to down a cup and zip through your workload, but at what cost?

Then there's **Yellowstone 88 – A Song of Fire** is a narrative poem that tells of a terrible wildfire that blazed through drought-struck Yellowstone Park in 1988. Breathtakingly gorgeous, as the fire and peril ramp up it leaves you with your heart in your throat. If this one makes it into the festival, it's a must see!

If you think animated films are just for kids, do yourself a favour and stop by our Animation session at next year's festival. I think you'll be pleasantly surprised!

Walking Football for Women

'Have fun, get fit, meet some new people and have a laugh over a cuppa afterwards' is how Chris Clift described the new walking football sessions for women at the Chilwell Memorial Institute's artificial multi-sport court. Walking football is a an increasingly popular sport for all ages and abilities and requires no previous expertise in football!

Chris said 'The success of the Lionesses during the summer has raised the profile of women's football and so made walking football a more attractive option for women who want to keep fit and have a bit of fun'.

'It's an ideal game for those who like to gently participate in a robust sport!' said Chris.

Walking football is a five or six a-side game played on a pitch about the size of a tennis court. It suits all ages and abilities and there is no heading nor running – only walking! 'It's excellent for helping with co-ordination and getting fit!' said Chris.

'Walking' groups are the new way for older residents to still participate in sport but in a manner more suited to their age and ability'. The Institute is expanding its walking football men's group and is now offering walking football for women as well as mixed groups.

The venture is run in partnership with the Nottingham Bramcote Walking Football Club and takes place on Friday mornings in the heart of Chilwell.

#### **International Artist**


Beeston artist Pamela Glover will be exhibiting her work internationally for the first time this November.



# freedom foundation



Celebrate their fifth fulfilling year...

Children around the world are struggling with anxiety and their overall physical and mental well-being, and Freedom Foundation has succeeded in its aim to tackle rising mental health issues among young people across Nottinghamshire.

Nottingham based social enterprise Freedom Foundation has been at the forefront of the East Midland's battle with bettering the mental health of young people, building partnerships with schools, Nottingham City Council, Nottingham County Council, Nottinghamshire Police, and many more.

The organisation was set up by two single working mums, Laura Grant, and Stacey Green, both 47, with a vision to help people. Co-founder Laura Grant emphasises how the foundation's work is more important now than ever before

"Five years on we've remained core to our vision-to support children and young people's mental and physical well-being, and upon our fifth year we have no plans to stop.

We are working on expanding our programmes to include University settings, and we now employ 8 full time staff and over 50 contractors within our own office in Nottingham's Antenna building. This is just the beginning for us.'

Freedom Foundation has reached 3635 young people ages between 2 and 25 since the organisation's creation, delivering a total of 121 programmes, with the Holiday and Food Provision Programme at Forest alone reaching 1000 children.

The importance of the organisation's work is emphasised by Young Minds' research showing that in the UK today, an estimated five children in every classroom has a mental health problem.

The charity also reports that 1 in 6 children aged 5 to 16 were identified as having a probable mental health problem in July 2020, with social media playing a huge part in this.

Freedom Foundation has successfully worked to alleviate the anxieties of young people surrounding social media, with 87% saying that the HAF Release Clubs helped to increase their confidence, and 88% saying the Motivational Mornings Programme helped them to understand more about being safe

Since the start of September 2022, 186 children have been reached in schools across the county and 9 different projects have been carried out, including in SEND schools.

The company's incredible work is only set to get better, as the highly popular Food Provision Release Clubs will benefit children in Cotgrave, Hucknall, Clipstone, Forest, and Bestwood.
