An OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography) machine is used to take a 3D scan of the eve to allow a specialist to assess the health of the optic nerve, macular and to detect and monitor the progression of conditions like age-related macular degeneration (AMD) and glaucoma. John Flynn Opticians' new machine, though, builds on this technology to create 4D imagery accurate to just a single micron - one hundredth of the width of a human hair.

The system also uses artificial intelligence to track the exact position of successive scans, overlaying them precisely to check changes over successive months or years. Fast, contact-free and painless, the system can also send images to hospital departments for other clinicians to review in the event of a referral.

"We can use the technology to examine tiny details that help us to detect eye disease at the earliest stages, reducing the risk of sight loss and improving our patients' lives," says Dr Janjua.

TICKETS are available to buy online and at Oxfam Books and Music on the High Street - keep your eye on the






## beeston film festival

**Bringing Hollywood to Beeston by Sam Kurd**

"As the nights start to draw in and Autumn knocks the damp dead leaves off its boots, we here at the Beeston Film Festival step up our efforts to watch and evaluate the haul of submissions we've had up til now. Time marches on, after all, and the new festival will be upon us sooner than we think!


What a haul it's been so far! At the time of writing, we've passed 500 submissions from 53 countries. It's a treasure trove of small, independent films telling grand stories on an international scale.

But just because a film is independent doesn't necessarily mean it can't be glamorous. One thing we've noticed this year is that we're getting a growing number of films featuring some familiar faces, some very exciting stars!

#### Here's a few I've spotted so far:

First is **The Cunning**, a powerful and moving film starring Gemma Arterton (The Girl With All the Gifts) and Bethany Asher (The Dumping Ground) as sisters accused of witchcraft in 18th Century England.

Then there's the Sci-fi film **Daylight Rules**, starring T'nia Miller (Years & Years) and David Ajala (Star Trek Discovery). In the future, some humans have the dangerous ability to harness the power of the sun and are hunted out of fear and ignorance. It's a film about family, trust and facing our fears.



**Moustache Man** stars Sean Joseph Young (Shoebox Zoo) as a young man who struggles to balance caring for his Alzheimer's-stricken mother (played by improv legend Josie Lawrence) and impressing his smarmy boss (played by comedian and writer Mark Gatiss). This one really doesn't pull its punches!

**Norma** is a dark comedy starring Susie Blake (Coronation Street) as a long-suffering pensioner whose attempts to celebrate her birthday highlight the deep resentment between her and her husband. Shot in one location and conceived over lockdown, it's an excellent portrayal of how claustrophobic and stifling a relationship can grow to become.

Finally, in our Non-Fiction category there's **Bad Hombrewood**, a thoughtful documentary about racism in Hollywood faced by Latinx people both in front of and behind the camera. There are many great interviewees here, but most notable are Melissa Fumero (Brooklyn 99) and legendary director Guillermo del Toro (Pan's Labyrinth).

Here's hoping these films make it into the final selections, so we can bring a little bit of Hollywood magic to Beeston's doorstep!"

have returned with a new production



There's something stirring in the bell tower.... as Nottingham Operatic Society prepares for one of its biggest musical productions: The Hunchback of Notre Dame at Nottingham's Theatre Royal in October.

It marks the return of the Society's annual shows after an absence of two years. Rehearsals are well underway, with a cast of 50, for this new musical, based on the original Victor Hugo novel and songs from the iconic Disney film.

Nottingham's Theatre Royal, will stage the seven performance production from Wednesday 26th to Saturday 29th October 2022.

Simon Theobald, Chair of Nottingham Operatic Society (NOS), who appears in the production as Dom Claude Frollo, the Archdeacon of Notre Dame, commented: "As the Society enters its 130th season this show promises to be one of our most challenging and powerful productions. It is an epic story of passion, hope and redemption and has everything- stunning music, a spectacular story, sword fights, puppets and a stellar local cast.

Simon explained: "Nottingham Operatic Society approached Disney Theatrical Productions five years ago to seek the rights to stage this musical and asked Disney to support our plans for a real community production in one of the UK's leading touring venues. We were thrilled when Disney Theatricals and MTI said yes!"

He added: "I am so proud to be Chair of this and transformative Society. amazing All members and our musical, production and support teams have pulled together throughout the two years when we couldn't

perform but have become stronger and more creative. The Society kept working musically through the pandemic, rehearsing in many unusual spaces around Nottingham.'

The musical has powerful leading roles for experienced local singers and actors including: Quasimodo, played by Zak Charlesworth; Sarah Millington as Esmeralda; Richard Groves as Captain Phoebus de Martin and Chris Grantham as Clopin Trouillefou. They are supported by narrators, choir and ensemble. International Director Andrew Miller makes his NOS debut as the

show's Director and the accomplished Morven Harrison returns as Musical Director, leading the 18 piece or chestra. The unique gargoyle puppets used in the show have been created by local company Promotional Props and Costume.

The Hunchback of Notre Dame comes from Academy Award winners Alan Menken (Little Shop of Horrors, The Little Mermaid, Aladdin) and Stephen Schwartz (Godspell, Pippin, Wicked) with a dramatic book by Peter Parnell, originally developed by Disney Theatrical Productions and presented by arrangement with Music Theatre International (Europe).

Since it was founded in 1893 as one of the Nottingham Mechanics Institution's social groups, Nottingham Operatic Society has performed over 135 shows and concerts in all of the City's famous venues. Since 1925, its spiritual home has been Nottingham's Theatre Royal. NOS has been a registered charity since 1958. Its last show pre-pandemic was the hugely successful Sound of Music in 2019.

The Hunchback of Notre Dame opens with a matinee and evening performance on Wednesday 26 October and runs until Saturday 29 October 2022. Tickets are on sale via the Theatre Royal at 0115 989 5555 or TRCH.CO.UK.





"We are also really excited that BWP will be using Sandra's book and course to deliver 'The Survivor's Programme', our new recovery programme."





9 tips to turn gardens into a wildlife heaven...

#### Bird boxes

Bird boxes make great havens for flying visitors, but it is important to install them high up in a sheltered area. Putting out food such as fat balls and seeds, also encourages birds to the gardens. Place feeders close to a covered bush to discourage unwanted cats.

Bug hotels

Bug hotels are a great activity to do with children, and can really encourage all kinds of insects into outside spaces. Simply organise a selection of twigs, rocks and rotting wood in piles around the garden. Soon enough, bugs such as beetles and spiders will be settling in!

#### **Grow native flowers**

Flowers add a beautiful scent and colourful landscape to gardens, but they also importantly provide food for insects. Grow lots of varieties of flowers to ensure that bugs are provided with food all year round. Pick out native flowers specifically, as insects and bugs have already evolved to feed off these.

#### Leave the weeds

In a patch in the garden, have a break from weeding. Weeds such as nettles, buttercups and daisies may be unwanted in some gardens, but will really attract wildlife. Insects rely on weeds as important sources of food because they flower throughout the year when other food sources may be scarce.

#### Compost

Using homemade compost will not only heavily enrich the soil of gardens, but also provide habitat for insects. Worms, woodlice, frogs and slowworms will all make home in composts, and will speed up the decomposition process too. To avoid any rats, ensure to only add raw foods into the compost.

#### Hedgehog highways With rapidly

declining levels of hedgehog

populations throughout the UK, clear a 'hedgehog highway' in the garden to help the animals. Leave gaps in the fence for hedgehogs to move through, and ask neighbours to do the same. This way, during their nighttime travels, hedgehogs can stick to the safety of gardens and avoid any urban dangers.

#### Plant climbers

Plant climbers up garden walls and fences to encourage a wealth of bugs, insects and birds. Flowers and seeds from ivy provide a great source of pollen and food, as well as long term cover for visitors such as caterpillars. Pyracantha is also a great climber for wildlife as its spring flowers and autumn berries give seasonal food for garden visitors.

#### Herbs

Herbs can be grown in the garden for not only culinary purposes, but to also attract wildlife. The flowering thyme will encourage butterflies and bees, as well as the nectar and pollen from flowering sage plants. Angelica gives food for insects too, and birds will eat the seeds.

#### Wildflowers

Grow a garden sized meadow to encourage a wildlife haven. Scatter seeds of poppies, cornflowers, cowslip, nigella and varieties of grass. Wildflowers are fantastically low maintenance, look wonderful, and insects love them for food and shelter purposes.



"To slightly misquote Gloria Gaynor, "We have survived!". In fact, Wollaton Singers are ready to blossom once more.

Through the pandemic/lockdowns, we kept the choir going on Zoom (a bit odd to sing on your own), then socially distanced in a room with all the windows and doors open wide (although it was cold, we were keen!) but we are now back singing together, performing and looking to grow.

Although you can drop in and try us on any Tuesday evening in term time, this year we are having a special Taster Session on Tuesday 6th September for ladies who like to sing and would like to try singing with others. Rehearsals (7.30pm to 9.30pm, with a tea break) are at St Barnabas Church, Inham Nook – a lovely big space with good acoustics, right on the 36 bus route and near the tram.

Don't be put off by the name 'Wollaton Singers' as this is the result of our history and we now rehearse and perform mostly in NG9.

Also as a result of our history, the choir is for women only and we sing mostly in 3 parts: soprano 1,2 and alto. Music is provided and we sing short pieces from a wide range of styles. Our recent concerts included pieces such as 'Bridge over Troubled Water', 'A Nightingale Sang in Berkeley Square', 'This is me!' and the theme tune to 'The Vicar of Dibley'. We have also performed songs from various musicals including 'Sister Act', 'West Side Story' and 'Les Misérables'.

We are extremely fortunate in having an outstanding Music Director in Sophie Pascall who is not only very knowledgeable and experienced, but also encouraging and fun. With her guidance over the past 5 years, the choir has developed markedly. One long term supporter commented, "You have come on so much. The attack, the contrasts in dynamics, articulation and sheer musicality have massively developed" (JBH). Sophie is ably supported by our accompanist, Rebecca Temple, who also brings extensive experience with other choirs to bear.

Our year runs from September until June, and we take breaks at Christmas and Easter, with concerts being put on towards the end of each term. Occasionally, we do additional performances to raise money for charities, e.g., Christmas carol singing in Tesco's, or singing at the Memory Café in Beeston.
