

### Adventure calls for retired Beeston civil servant who scales dizzying heights with u3a

Nigel Statham doesn't consider himself an action man, but he does love to keep active and busy.

After retiring from the Civil Service, he joined national learning movement u3a and signed up to the Adventures

Outside Your Comfort Zone group – just one of a number of high-octane adventure groups across the movement.

The organsiation supports older adults to learn new skills and develop friendships in networks online and in

person for as little as £20 per year. It's open to anyone who is no longer in full-time work.

Nigel, a member of Beeston u3a says: "I retired just before lockdown which was very frustrating but gave me time to sort the house out and all the paperwork I'd accumulated over the years. It also helped me really appreciate my local area."

But he was yearning to fire up his social and active life again once it was over, that's when he joined u3a. There are more than 1,000 u3as across the country with hundreds of interest groups to choose from.

Nigel quickly signed up for table tennis, family history, the landscape and environment group and singing for fun. His head was really turned by the new Adventures Outside Your Comfort Zone group. "And a climbing wall was certainly outside of my comfort zone", laughs Nigel as he recalls scaling the wall of his local climbing centre with other new members. "I'm not an action man at all but it was a great opportunity, and I was really up for giving it a go."

It gave the original group of six a taste for excitement, and their numbers have swelled to two dozen members with ambitions take part in zip lining, paddleboarding and even axe throwing. Friendships have been forged and a couple of adrenaline-junkie members have signed up to do a sky dive together.


Nigel says he is delighted to have joined the u3a movement and adds: "It is a great way to meet people, try different things and continue your search for knowledge, no matter your age."





Nick Wild of Bramcote, Nottingham has been selected to represent the England under-16 Basketball team as they head out to Dublin this month to compete in the Four Nations tournament, playing the home countries and Ireland.

> Nick will be hoping to catch the GB selectors' eyes at this tournament ahead of a busy international summer schedule for those selected.

> > Standing at 6'8" and still only 15 years old, Nick has always been taller than all of his peers. This height is ideal for his position of Centre which means that he's responsible for stopping the opposition getting near the basket, blocking shots and fighting for rebounds.

From age 5 Nick was taken on by coach Tracey West from the local basketball club; Chilwell Comets who train at Chilwell Olympia. He competed in the Nottinghamshire Open under-12s league from age 6 alongside his sister (see picture) and later represented Nottinghamshire at County competitions.

Nick then moved to Derby Trailblazers Basketball Club at age 10 in order to

compete in National League competitions and went on to represent the East Midlands region in Basketball England's Aspire programme.

A major operation put Nick out of all sport for 6 months, but his love of the game saw him fight back to full fitness, eventually playing in both the under-16 and under-18 age groups in the 2022/23 season.

Currently attending the George Spencer Academy, Nick has had much to balance with his upcoming GCSEs and his basketball commitments.

From September, he will be part of the Derby Trailblazers Basketball Academy running out of the Derby College group. Trailblazers compete in the Elite Academy Basketball League (EABL), the highest college league in England.

Who knows where this journey will lead, maybe to playing College Basketball in America, maybe to a team in the UK or Europe. But for now, we will all be behind Nick as he takes his first steps onto the international stage in April.






# beeston film festival

What a great festival that was! So much fun, so glamorous! Who could believe that we'd sell out every session and break box office records? And the celebrities, wow, I was blown away!

OK, perhaps that's taking it a little too far.

In any case, we're so proud to be able to bring our humble film festival back for the ninth year in a row, and we're so grateful for the continued support of our beloved home town.

Next month we'll cover which films won our coveted B'Oscar awards, but for now here's a few more of the outstanding short films you will see/have already seen (sorry) at the festival:

**Bona Vacancia** is a drama about a council worker whose job is to investigate the homes of the recently-deceased. It's a tough unsung job, and it's no wonder she finds herself fixating on death so much.

**Unders** follows a group of teens in Glasgow at an under-18s club night, exploring the toxic behaviour of these boys and how it affects their girl friends. A sobering look at a very serious problem.

Over in the Horror category there's **Hidden Mother**, a period film about a businesswoman in the late 19th Century who discovers her client's deeply upsetting family secret. It's not a bells-and-whistles and jumpscares-aplenty affair; this is a superb exercise in how to ramp up tension and unease.

Sticking with uneasy moods, **Lapse** is a psychological thriller about the danger of one-night-stands, especially if you're already married. While it may be innocent fun or a mostly harmless lapse of judgement most of the time, our cardiologist heroine discovers the hard way that sometimes you just don't know who you're taking to bed. It's a gender-flipped Fatal Attraction!



Gardening expert Chris Bonnett from GardeningExpress.co.uk says last year's unprecedented weather with record high temperatures and water shortages could be seen again this year if current rainfall levels are anything to go by.

Already experts are talking about drought conditions. A recent meeting of the National Drought Group noted 63% of rivers are currently below normal levels for this time of year.

Rainfall over the next three months will be vital in reducing the drought risk for the summer.

Now gardeners are being encouraged to think about what they plant and opt for drought tolerant varieties to keep their garden looking healthy.

Chris Bonnett from GardeningExpress.co.uk said: "Last year was unlike any summer I've ever seen and these intense periods of heat and lack of rainfall are likely to become more prevalent.

"Gardeners need to adapt and think about what they can grow that's tolerant of these difficult conditions. There are lots of options from favourites like lavender to more unusual plants like passion flowers.

"There's also other things gardeners can be doing now like installing water butts to collect rainwater to water their garden."



Here is GardeningExpress.co.uk's suggestions for drought tolerant plants:

**Lavender** is a staple in a UK garden with the beautiful blue flowers and the distinctive fragrance. It's also a good drought tolerant plant. Try planting close to a path or in a garden border to fully enjoy the scent. Lavender also works well in planters on the patio or deck. And the added bonus? Beneficial insects like bees and butterflies love them.

#### Passion Flower -

This exotic climber copes with a lack of rain well and thrives during hot summers. This is a show stopper in the garden. The white flowers with central rings of purple, blue and white spiky filaments are in full bloom from July to September, followed by egg-shaped, orange-yellow fruit. These are perfect for a tropical garden but look stunning whatever your garden theme.



**Hebe** - Drought tolerant Hebes are the ultimate foliage plants providing interest all year round. These evergreen shrubs will add colour and texture to your outside space. The low growing domes of densely packed leaves can be plated just about everywhere. They're virtually maintenance free, frost hardy, drought tolerant and tolerant of shade, sun and poor soil.

**Perovskia -** This drought tolerant small shrub is also known as Russian Sage. Its aromatic leaves and upright spikes of violet blue flowers make a lovely display in the garden. It flowers from late July through to September. Try planting alongside a path to fully enjoy the sage-like fragrance of its leaves.






