



64 Million Artists announces its 11th January Challenge for 2024 with thirty-one Creativity Champions. Children's Laureate Wales, Alex Wharton, artist Krystal Lowe, CBeebies' presenter Nigel Clarke, poet Michael Rosen and a host of community partners are joining in. Each day, one Creativity Champion offers a suggestion for creative thinking, making, seeing and doing. The January Challenge activities are all free, accessible, and available in person at local workshops and online.

64 Million Artists is a social enterprise inviting everyone in the UK to explore their creative potential and unlock the power of their imagination. Since 2012, every year over 50,000 people across the UK have explored their individual creativity with The January Challenge. Every morning throughout January, an inspiring invitation to be creative is emailed directly to everyone who is signed up.

The January Challenge is a mass participatory national campaign designed to boost creativity during the gloomiest month of the year and improve well-being and happiness. It is a celebration of everyday creativity across the UK featuring well-known and local community Creativity Champions from across the UK, including writers, makers, and community groups. They have contributed ideas for the daily creative challenges and will host virtual events, contribute to podcasts and run in-person workshops for the 31 days of January.

"Creativity is... Doing It Yourself, Doing It Together. Creativity is... How we survive this, how we imagine a different world, how we craft it together." Lea Cooper

Creativity can be explored alone, with friends and family or as part of a teaching plan, library event, or team engagement at work or in any community setting. The January Challenge encourages people taking part online to build a community by sharing what they have created on social media.

Also taking part is Ica Headlam from We Are Here Scotland, artist and illustrator Shilpi Sahu from India, graphic artist Nadina Did This from Marseille in France and Edinburgh-based Zine maker and librarian Lea Cooper

Community organisations taking part as Creativity Champions include Frimley NHS, The Jo Cox Foundation, HMP Berwyn in Wrexham, Scottish Libraries, The Warm Welcome Campaign and Hill Care Homes.

Michael Rosen, Poet says: "The January Challenge is a lovely idea for people to think about the fact that you've got creativity inside you. Everybody has - they're doing gardening and thinking, 'Well, I'll put this over there, and do this over there, I'll just try that out' - that's actually creativity! If you just name five of the major problems of the world, or whatever it is, you can be sure that they need creative ways of dealing with them. Because if you're not creative about them, you'll just repeat your mistakes. So we need creativity. When you put something out there, either onto a piece of paper, or what you've actually done, is taken something out of your head, and this enables you to look at yourself taking you beyond feeling satisfied, it takes you into a kind of serenity."

Nigel Clarke, founder of Dadvengers and CBeebies' presenter said: "I think The January Challenge is amazing. It's really accessible for people because it just allows people to get into whatever might interest them. One creative prompt could be paints and things like that and another one could be music. I do a lot of work with parents and families and I started something called Dadvengers, we're using that platform to share The January Challenge creative prompts for families and specifically for dads and men to get involved as it's usually a little bit more difficult to get men involved in creative activities."

Jo Hunter, Co-founder and CEO, 64 Million Artists said: "The January Challenge has supported thousands of people to be creative even when they didn't think they could be. Ideas have the possibility to change the world, and seeing ideas spark in so many people throughout this usually gloomy month brings joy to everyone who joins in. This year we are thrilled to have 31 incredible Creative Champions delivering fun and thoughtful suggestions to brighten the dark winter days. We really believe that using our creativity can make positive change in our lives and the world around us."

December already? I guess it's true what they say: time flies when you're having fun watching independent films from all around the world for the Midlands' best film festival! It's a very specific proverb, very niche, I think it might be French.

Let's be honest, though; it's been another tough year, at home and abroad. It can sometimes feel like the darkness is overwhelming and hope is just a flickering candle on the windowsill. But this is just the time of year for hope, and a host of candles can keep the dark at bay.

So look after that spark of hope, nurture it in your friends and neighbours, and let's all do our best to take care of each other. Eat good food together, laugh together... and watch excellent films together!

At the time of writing we've had nearly 850 submissions, a new record for us, with plenty of time for more to come in before we shut up shop at the end of this month.

#### Here's a few top-scoring standouts:

In keeping with the season, there's **The Inkeeper**, a heart-warming Irish film about a little girl in a nativity play who absolutely doesn't want to turn Mary & Joseph away. It's extremely funny, but surprisingly moving once you realise why she's so set on it.

**Art** is a comedy that follows a Cornish pensioner who turns to painting to save herself & her husband from financial ruin. I'd never heard Cornish before, it's a beautiful language!

Supertramp is an animated film that doesn't so much tug on the heartstrings as yank on them! It's about a stray puppy that's adopted by a little girl but goes through terrible hardship to be reunited with her, many years later, after they get forcibly separated. Bring tissues!

Dear Vladimir is a cheeky thumbed-nose to a certain Russian statesman from a Ukrainian refugee living in the UK. It's a little slice of life and a powerful reminder that refugees are human beings and not statistics.


And finally there's punnily titled






The property is constructed of block and beam flooring to both the ground and most of the first floor, which also has underfloor heating, there are 14 solar panels to the roof and a rainwater harvester which provides water for two toilets and two outside taps. As people will see when they view each bedroom has a highly appointed en-suite bathroom/shower room and there is the open plan dining/living kitchen which was fitted by Steven Christopher with glass fronted charcoal coloured wall and base units, Corian work surfaces and several high quality integrated appliances and from the dining/sitting room part of this room there are bi-folding doors leading out to the landscaped rear garden.

The property is constructed of an attractive facia brick to the external elevations with stone lintels and sills to the windows under a pitched tiled roof with the spacious and tastefully finished accommodation benefiting from the underfloor heating system to two floors and radiators to the second floor and triple glazed sash style windows throughout.

### From chosing the right Christmas tree to keeping the wildlife happy. Here's this month's gardening...

With the festive season underway, Brits are being told of important signs that indicate their Christmas tree is healthy.

Experts at have listed seven important elements that a healthy tree should display.

Many families prefer real trees over artificial ones for their fresh pine scent and nostalgic feel.

A healthy tree will keep its charm throughout December ensuring it still looks great on Christmas Day.

Key indications of a healthy tree include a strong and sturdy trunk, a bright colour and a fresh aroma.

Chris Bonnett, the founder of said: "Picking out a Christmas tree is a significant festive tradition for many families, but with the abundance of different options, it can be overwhelming to choose the right one.

"Our representatives keep an eye on our Christmas trees as they grow in sustainably sourced plantations to ensure all customers get a healthy tree that will keep its spark all the way until Christmas Day. There are certain things they look out for to ensure a tree is up to standard.

"Instead of relying solely on appearances, it's important to inspect the tree to determine how fresh it is

"Simple checks like running your hands through the branches and checking for signs of dryness or needle loss can tell you a lot about how healthy the tree is." Seven signs of a healthy Christmas tree:

#### 1. Fragrance of tree

Different trees will have different scents but a strong, pleasant and fresh aroma is a good indication of a healthy tree. Musty and mouldy smells are signs of potential decay.

#### 2. Evenly distributed branches

Evenly distributed branches show that a tree has been taken care of properly. Any bare spots show that the tree has been under stress meaning it won't last until Christmas Day.



#### 3. The colour

Colour is a prominent sign of a healthy tree! You want your tree to look as bright and green as possible. Don't forget to take a close look at the whole tree to make sure there isn't any grey or brown colouring, as it can be a sign of a dying tree.

#### 4. The location of the tree

Opt for a tree that has been kept in a partially shaded spot. Trees that have been kept in a partially shaded spot allow for a smoother transition when the tree is brought indoors, as it has already acclimated to protection from direct sunlight.

#### 5. Condition of needles

Evaluate the needles for their flexibility, as sturdy needles that snap easily indicate an unhealthy tree. The needles should be resilient and pliable so you can easily hang your ornaments on them.

#### 6. Shedding of needles

Gently run your hands through the branches or tap the tree trunk to check for needle shedding. While some needle loss is expected, excessive shedding should be a red flag. This indicates the tree may not be as fresh as desired.

#### 7. Sturdy trunk

A sturdy trunk is essential for safety and is a positive sign of a healthy Christmas tree. It indicates the tree has been well cared for and has developed properly.
