Derby Road, Long Eaton, NG10 4AX £875,000 Freehold

Robert Ellis are pleased to be instructed to market this Edwardian detached residence which is impressive from the front, but even more impressive when you take an internal inspection to see the spacious and tastefully finished accommodation which is arranged on three floors.

In recent years the property has been extended at the rear and this has created a fantastic dining/living kitchen which has two sets of bi-folding doors leading out to the patio and garden at the rear. There is a private drive off Douglas Road which leads to a Presscrete parking area and a detached brick built garage block which could store up to three vehicles and therefore helps to make this an ideal home for a car or motorbike enthusiast or could be used as an ideal storage facility or a place to run a business from home.

The property still retains many of its original features such as Minton tiled flooring in the reception hall, there are original pine doors leading to all the rooms on the ground

and first floor levels, cornices, picture rails and exposed pine flooring in several rooms. Most of the windows have been replaced throughout this beautiful home with UPVC sash style windows so they are in keeping with the original windows when the property was built at the beginning of the last century and at the front the main reception rooms and bedrooms have fitted shutters which will remain at the property when it is sold.

We cannot recommend enough the need for people in search of a period property in the West Nottingham area to have a full inspection of this lovely home so they can see the internal space provided and garaging at the bottom of the garden for themselves.

The property stands behind a stone wall on Derby Road and is entered through the original front door which leads into an impressive main reception hall which has Minton tiled flooring and stairs with a feature balustrade and wood panelling to the side leading to the first floor and the original pine doors leading to the three reception rooms, ground floor w.c. and beneath the stairs there is a pine door taking you to a most useful basement. At the end of

the main hall there is an inner hallway and a door leading to the superb living/dining kitchen which has been recently re-fitted with high quality Shaker style units and granite work surfaces and includes several integrated appliances which will all remain when the property is sold. This room really is a focal point of the property and we are sure it is the style of living space many people are looking for with its bi-folding doors leading out to the private rear garden and there is a large utility/laundry room off the reception hall which also provides excellent ground floor storage space.

The first floor landing is also spacious and has large windows to the front which are Southerly facing and therefore provide a lot of natural light into this part of the property, two possible main bedrooms from the four bedrooms on the first floor with the largest room being at the rear and this is adjacent to the main bathroom, but could easily have an en-suite bathroom facility created with a small extension at the rear of the property and then there is a second possible main bedroom which has a full bathroom en-suite with a roll top bath and separate walkin shower. There are two further double bedrooms to the first floor and a walk-in airing/storage cupboard which houses the main gas central heating boiler and hot water storage tank. From the first floor landing there is a second flight of stairs taking you to the second floor where the landing leads to two further double bedrooms, both of which have vaulted ceilings and there is a full bathroom which has a separate shower as well as a bath.

The second floor space provides an ideal bedroom and a living area for older children who might want to have a certain amount of independent living while still being at the family home

Outside there is a stone walled garden at the front and a path running down the right hand side through a gate to the rear garden. At the rear of the property there is a patio extending across the rear of the house and this includes a base for a hot tub and from the patio there is a recently laid astroturf lawn and a path which takes you to the bottom of the garden where the garage building is positioned.

Being located on Derby Road the property is very close to Trent College and The Elms independent schools and to other well known state schools for all ages of

children, Asda and Tesco superstores and many other retail outlets are found in Long Eaton town centre, there are healthcare and sports facilities including the West Park Leisure Centre and adjoining playing fields, walks at West Park and in the nearby countryside and transport links.


Happy New Year from Beeston Film Festival! by Sam Kurd







Novice gardeners are being offered 23 gardening tips for 2023 to help them make the most out of their outdoor space. The gardening experts at have looked at the things every gardener needs to know. 23 TIPS FOR 2023

1. Plan your garden

Sit down and figure out what you want to do with your garden over the coming year and how you want to use it. Think about what you want to grow and how you can best utilise the space.

2. Know your garden

Getting to know your garden is vital. For example, is it north or south facing? What soil type do you have? This will play a massive part in your planting scheme and where you place entertaining areas.

3.Understand what to plant when

Once you have a bit of a plan, it's time to think about planting. Do your research and make sure you plant the right ones at the right time in the right place.

4. Caring for your plants

Plants need looking after. Think about the weather conditions, where they're placed in the garden and how best to protect them. For example, pots in full sunlight on the patio may need moving somewhere shady during high temperatures.

5. Looking after the soil

Soil needs to be nutrient rich and well drained. You can add nutrients with different types of compost.

6. Watering

Develop a watering schedule to plan, especially during dry, hot sunny spells.

7. Growing fruit and vegetables

If you're going to grow your own fruit and vegetable, start small and opt for easy to look after, low maintenance varieties. Salad veg, potatoes and rhubarb are a good place to start

8. Lawn care

If you have a lawned area in your garden, keep it cut and well looked after. It too needs watering and feeding, especially during the summer.

9. Controlling pests

Try to avoid spraying your garden with chemicals to control pests. Instead opt for natural methods like attracting beneficial insects.

10. Good bugs

Ladybirds, hoverflies, wasps, bees and spiders are the bugs you want in the garden to keep the nasty, plant eating bugs at bay.

11. Attracting wildlife

Do try and encourage wildlife into your garden. Birds are great at nibbling pests and bees pollinate the plants.

12. Composting

Why not create your own compost bin? Food scraps, grass cuttings and other garden waste all makes for great compost.

13. Outdoor entertaining

If you love entertaining, create an area within your garden for comfy seating, somewhere you can eat and a BBQ.

Do remember to enjoy your garden. Whether that's with a good book, a glass of wine with friends or watching the wildlife, enjoy your outdoor space.





Small steps but lots of them mean we can make an impact. We might not change the world but we are going to have fun trying!



new year, new hope



2023 sees the Canaan Trust moving forward with its plans to develop and open a new dedicated Female House for women who are homeless and in need.

The Trust purchased an additional property in 2022.

In the interim architects were commissioned to design a facility which could provide suitable, secure supported accommodation for 9 homeless females. These plans have now received approval from the Planning Authorities and so the Trust can now look to move forward to obtain tenders from appropriate construction companies to carry out the works. The works are extensive and will cost in the region of £400,000.

Females who are homeless and vulnerable invariably have potentially suffered physical or sexual abuse either prior to becoming homeless or possibly post their being homeless. Homelessness for females is NOT identical to the experience of homelessness

for males and yet most of the data and resources are built on the male 'model' of homelessness.

Currently there are few facilities available to safeguard, support, and provide for females who are homeless or in danger of becoming homeless. The primary help available means that a female has to accept being accommodated in a mixed gender hostel invariably with men who may have a complex range of issues which are not necessarily appropriate for a vulnerable female who has experienced abuse.

The Trust has for many years recognised this grave need and has always looked to safeguard and support females in need enabling to access and obtain the appropriate help and support to address their homelessness. This has often been challenging. Prior to Christmas while supporting one female in need staff at the Trust had to phone services across seven counties seeking a place which was appropriate for her needs.

There is a dire need for a female only service and facility. Even now, with the Trust having announced that it is working to create and open such a house the Trust is receiving calls from statutory services (social care) asking when the service/facility will be available.

The Trust operates 24-7, 365 days a year as homelessness and need are not restricted to Monday to Friday, 9 to 5. The Trust provides more than a safe bed for the night. The Trust's objective is to enable and empower each unique individual to address the often complex issues which have contributed to their becoming homeless. Each individual is supported in a holistic manner meaning that their physical, emotional, mental health, financial needs are provided for. The Trust has its own 'education facility' which provides access to training with an extensive range of 'Life Skills', Employability Skills, and Emotional Resilience. Clients can engage with the Trust's 'in-house' Counsellor enabling them to deal with the often deep seated traumas and hurts which may have been a significant catalyst in their becoming homeless.

Ultimately for the Trust the aim is to support, enable and empower each individual to "Re-Build their Lives" and to move forward to achieve independent living in the community.

Sweet Potato Burger with Griddled Pineapple & Chilli Salsa

Serves 4-6 **Ingredients**

For the Burgers:

4-6 tiger roll buns 600g sweet potatoes

2 tbsp olive oil

1 onion, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, crushed

1 tsp ras-el-hanout

1 tsp rose harissa 100g breadcrumbs

50g almonds, coarsely chopped

100g pumpkin seeds, crushed

5 pineapple rings to coat gram flour

For the Simple Moroccan side salad:

250g cooked chickpeas, drained and rinsed

1 red onion finely sliced

2 tomatoes, chopped

100g finely sliced ready to eat apricots

100g watercress

1 tbsp olive oil

½ tsp cumin powder

Salt and pepper to taste

For the Relish:

3 birdseye chillies, finely chopped

2 spring onions, finely chopped

½ lemon, juiced

1 tbsp tomato puree

Method

Preheat the oven to 220C. Cut the sweet potatoes in half and bake in their skins on an oil coated baking tray for 30 minutes. While the potatoes are cooking you

can start on the burgers. When they are cooked scoop out the flesh and set aside.

Fry the onions in a little olive oil until soft then add the garlic and ras-el-hanout. Continue to fry for another 30 seconds.

Chop one of the pineapple rings into small cubes and put in a big bowl with the cooked sweet potato flesh, fried onions, rose harissa, breadcrumbs, almonds and pumpkin seeds. Season to taste.



Form the mixture into burgers. You can make one normal burger or two thin ones per bun. Coat them in the gram flour and shallow fry until golden on each side. While the burgers are frying make the relish by mixing all the ingredients together. At this point also start to griddle

the pineapple rings on each side. Assemble the burgers by placing one burger in each bun, followed by the griddled pineapple then the relish.




