Going forward, they have a new project in the making, working with local music producers and experimenting with different styles and genres of music, but their true passion will always be acoustic soul.



"My name is Liz and I have been a primary school teacher for 28 years. I started Mini Me Cake Toppers in 2017, making personalised celebration cake toppers out of clay. In 2022 I became a register baker and now also offer cookies and cakes

In 2022 I expanded my business to include Mini Me Clay Club. I run Clay Clubs at weekends and school holidays where children learn how to use the air-drying clay to make models, finger puppets, jewellery and many other clay related crafts. As well as giving the children step-by-step guidance to make models, I encourage the children to use their imagination to create their own masterpieces!

I also offer clay birthday parties where children can choose a theme such as dinosaurs, aliens or animals. I can package together a whole party if required, including clay games, prizes, party bags as well as, of course, the birthday cake! I am a firm believer in learning through play, and am about to launch a new Clay Club aimed at pre-school children. 

Discover how you can play your part in helping the Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance – delivering life-saving treatment, day and night.

At a time when every second counts, the arrival of the iconic yellow helicopter of the Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance (LNAA) really can mean the difference between life and death.

Covering both Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire, last year the LNAA team were called to 1,610 potentially life-saving missions. And this year is set to be equally as busy with the crew responding to 147 missions in April alone.

The crew are called to the most serious incidents ranging from road traffic accidents to agricultural, horse-riding and other sporting incidents. The doctor-paramedic team are highly trained, able to administer advanced pain relief, carry out enhanced life-saving medical procedures and give blood transfusions. This level of care and the speed at which the pilots can get to patients and get them to hospital is crucial. This is especially so when patients need to be taken to a Major Trauma Centre, the nearest being either at Nottingham or Hull. In some cases, this really can make the difference between life and death.

LNAA operates a 24/7 service with the helicopter able to take to the skies from 7am until 2am the following morning. After 2am, the critical care car takes over, ensuring that the equivalent of and A&E department can be brought to an incident whatever the time of day. But this amazing service comes at a price. For each mission costs on average $\pounds4,000$. As a charity, the Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance receives no direct government funding and is not part of the National Health Service. It relies solely on the generosity of the hundreds of volunteers, supporters and public donations to keep its helicopters flying and Critical Care Cars on the roads.





Festival in the sunny South of France – and this time I got to go along too!

It was absolutely lovely and I may have eaten twice my body weight in cheeses and pastries, but it was no cushy holiday, let me tell you! Our days were spent pacing the halls of the Film Market, looking for international film commissions and production companies to forge relationships with and to help us put Beeston on the global map when it comes to film.

Because here's a bit of surprise news for you: next year, we're expanding into feature films! We're still dedicated to bringing the best short films that the world has to offer, but now we're aiming to take the next step and showcase independent feature films too, films that otherwise might not even get the chance to be screened at cinemas like Broadway, let alone the big multiplex chains.

With this in mind, we met with film-makers (and at least one diplomat!) from all over the world – Romania, Ukraine, Jordan, Chile, Mongolia, South Africa, Brazil and even Birmingham!

We made our intentions plain: as we expand, we want to bring the world to Beeston and Beeston to the world. We caught a few of the official Cannes screenings, and we're making moves to invite them to screen at next year's 10th Beeston Film Festival, as part of our spectacular anniversary extravaganza.

A few of the highlights we saw, which I hope we'll be able to share with you next year:

Inshallah A Boy – A powerful drama from Jordan about the struggles of a woman who stands to lose her house after her husband dies because they didn't have a male child together. A snapshot of the struggles many women still face in the Arab world.

Le Règne Animal – As an epidemic causes people to mutate into animals, a father bonds with his son as they search the woods for the family's missing mother, who has become a wolf. As poignant as it is beautiful!

Steadfast – a documentary about the inspirational life of Dr Jean Augustine, a Canadian immigrant from Grenada who became the first Black woman elected to Canada's House of Commons. An important story of resilience in the face of hardship.

Cross your fingers that we'll be able to screen these remarkable films at our 10th Anniversary!

Living with dementia and caring for someone with dementia can be hard, so having a place to go to which offers support, fun and new experiences makes life a little less stressful. This is what The Studio in Beeston aims to provide.

"We are a small charity (No. 1199448) whose purpose is to give carers time and space for themselves and to give people living with dementia opportunities to be creative and - most importantly, to have fun.

The Studio has a varied programme of individual and group activities including outings to places of interest and Sporting Memories on Tuesday afternoons.

At The Studio carers can take time out, leaving the person with dementia with trained staff for a morning or an afternoon.

"To see David happy and contented in an environment that he feels comfortable in helps not only his wellbeing but the rest of the family who love him."

Alternatively, couples can come along to a 90-minute session where carers socialise separately whilst the people with dementia enjoy singing and conversation facilitated by experienced volunteers.

"We help one another knowing we are not going through the process on our own. These sessions are lifesavers for us and keep us sane."

Often carers feel isolated, particularly if the person they care for is in a home or has passed away. At The Studio we also provide a space for these carers to meet socially over a cup of tea to chat, share experiences and support each other.

The Studio is based at the Royal British Legion Hall, 16 The Hall Croft, Beeston, NG9 1EL and currently runs sessions Monday to Wednesday.

"We will be having an Open Day on Saturday 8th July to coincide with 'Thank You Day 2023', a national campaign organised by Music for Dementia.

Come and along and meet us, find out what we do, join in with some singing (not compulsory!) and enjoy a cup of tea".



"This is something you really want to consider especially if you have young children or if you plan on entertaining over the summer. It may be that some of your guests will prefer the shade.

The obvious option is to buy a parasol but you can do other things like invest in shade sails or even garden furniture with a built-in canopy.

Gardening Express' ways to create shade:

1. Invest in a parasol

The easiest way to create a shady spot in your garden is by purchasing a parasol. You can buy free standing ones that are easy to move around the garden, allowing you to create a shady spot anywhere.

2. Look into shade sails

Shade sails get hooked onto your home, trees or posts and allow a sheet to sit on top in order to block out any direct sunlight. The good thing about this option is that the sides are left open which will bring in a nice breeze.

You may not have space in your garden to grow plants and trees to create shade but the good thing is you can replicate this with hanging plants. Plants like English Ivy and Ferns are great for this because they're full and leafy. They look goodt and will continue to grow in the shade which is a bonus.

4. Consider a pergola

Depending on the size of your garden and your budget you may want to consider a pergola. These are great long term investment for those who do spend a lot of time outside. Their build provides relief from harsh sun but doesn't completely block it out.

5. Invest in the right furniture

If you are someone who does prefer the shade then make sure you're investing in the right garden furniture. Some garden sofas nowadays come with a built-in canopy. Not only will this save you the hassle of purchasing one separately but it will match your furniture and the prices of these kinds of garden sofas usually aren't more expensive than normal garden sofas.

6. Use plants and trees to block the sun

Positioning tall plants and trees will create a dappled shade, which will be enough for those who are looking to get away from the sun. The Gardening Express experts recommend Cotinus Coggygria 'Royal Purple' or bamboo and Silver Birches for this. For more information on shade loving plants read this handy guide.



THE BIG DIG AT STRELLEY HALL – DISCOVERING A HIDDEN CASTLE



Strelley Hall was the setting for an episode of The Great British Dig programme, when the team led by Hugh Dennis explored the site to uncover the remains of an old medieval castle under the Georgian stately home.

The archaeologists, assisted by a team of local volunteers, dug three trenches in the car park and gardens of the Strelley Hall. They found the old castle walls buried in the ground, plus several artefacts which enabled them to deduce a surprisingly detailed picture of what the medieval building would have looked like. No skeletons – but some other fascinating finds including interesting animal bones and oyster shells to help us understand what the castle's residents would have dined on, and medieval artefacts from the Great Hall of the castle. You can watch the programme which is due to be broadcast on More4 channel on Thursday 6th July.

Richard Henshell, who has lived in Strelley Hall for over 40 years, provides fascinating historical tours of the building. The next date is Wednesday 30th August, starting 1pm and followed by a delicious cream tea.

Throughout the centuries, Strelley Hall has been a wonderful party venue. There are stories of some amazing parties held in the 1930's hosted by the Edge family of Strelley Hall; and today you can hire the beautiful rooms for your own event.
