

# revving up



- Driving lessons in the scaled-down EV sports car launch at Nottingham - specifically for 4-10 year olds
- · Car aims to enthuse new generation of drivers about road safety and the growing importance of EVs

Nottingham will be one of the first locations in the world where drivers can get behind the wheel of an exciting new British-made electric vehicle.

But in a twist, the car is only for four to ten year olds. The all-electric Firefly Sport is packed full of British innovation and whilst it's designed to be educational, it has also been engineered to let youngsters experience some of the thrill of being in control of a vehicle.

Now four to ten year olds in the Nottingham area can try out the brand new Firefly Sport at Young Driver's Clifton South Tram Park and Ride venue. Lessons in the fully-fledged, scaled-down EV will begin on 30th April, taking place on selected weekend dates and costing just £20. The Firefly Sport, which debuted its prototype at the British Motor Show last year, is also available to purchase by private owners for £11,500.

A sister company to Young Driver – which specialises in driving lessons

and experiences for those not yet of a legal driving age - Young Driver Motor Cars (YDMC) is producing the 2.1 metre-long car at a workshop in the Midlands, with a team of experts who have previously worked on brands including JLR, MG, Aston Martin, Rover and BMW. The car, which can also accommodate adult drivers or passengers, will use only UKsourced components for series-build cars making Firefly Sport the country's first all-British EV.

Firefly Sport's speeds will be kept below 10mph for young drivers – fast enough to excite a youngster but controllable enough not to worry the adults! However, Firefly Sport also has a remote cut-off facility with a 200metre range, as well as an automatic cut-off if it senses obstacles in its path, making it ultra-safe for first-time drivers.

Ian Mulingani, YDMC's managing director, commented: "It's hoped the car will help educate youngsters about road safety and how future motor vehicles can be an environmental force for good - as well as being a lot of fun! It's designed to be straightforward and unintimidating, but being electric and looking like a junior supercar, it also aligns with the type of vehicle that children hope to drive when they pass their test. Having seen how young people respond behind the wheel, we can't wait to let the youngsters of Nottingham give it a go. It's all helping in our mission to create a next generation of safe, responsible motorists - as well as putting smiles on faces!





- Nottingham's to join hundreds of cities around the world who will be taking part in this global festival from 19th-24 May

From the 19th-24th May Pint of Science festival will bring scientists and their research out of the lab and into pubs near you. The festival has grown astronomically since its inception, and 2023 will see its tenth anniversary with events in over 25 countries and hundreds of cities around the world. The festival aims to showcase the brilliant work of scientist at both the local universities and industries that happening right on our doorsteps. Each night will provide a unique line up of talks, interactive activities and demonstrations held in a relaxed and informal environment. 

### New website heralded 'An Aladdin's cave for archaeologists, researchers and students', launched in Notts

Nottinghamshire County Council has launched a new Historic Environment Record (HER) website dedicated to thousands of historic sites in Nottinghamshire.

The new website, https://her.nottinghamshire.gov.uk, provides access to an expansive database of heritage sites, earthworks, historic buildings, and archaeological finds that make up the rich and varied historic environment of the county.

Features from the 25,000 data entries range from single chance finds, such as Roman coins, to large sites such as WWII airfields. The site contains records of designated heritage assets such as listed buildings, scheduled monuments and registered parks and gardens, as well as undesignated ones such as other historic buildings and structures, archaeological sites and historic landscapes.

Thousands of records are waiting to be discovered, including one of Nottinghamshire's smallest Roman forts at Scaftworth and a brand-new high-resolution laser scan of Sherwood Forest.

Using the search tools and mapping window, visitors to the website are encouraged to explore the range of sources available. This includes George Sanderson's 1835 Map of The Country Twenty Miles Around Mansfield, along with aerial satellite map, OS map, and two high-resolution lidar models. Surveys and excavation reports, plans, publications and collection of air and ground photographs are also online to explore.

Mark Walker, the County Council's Interim Service Director for Place and Communities said: "The Historic Environment Record website is an Aladdin's cave for archaeologists, researchers, students, schools and local groups wanting to find out more about the history of their local area.

"The website will be regularly updated with news on exciting archaeological and historic building projects taking place in the county along with discoveries, photos, volunteer opportunities, and stories that help to connect people to the place where they live."

"We hope people are inspired to find out more and enjoy delving into the fascinating history of our wonderful county.


"The website is not a replacement for official planning or commercial searches. These must still be conducted through the Nottinghamshire Historic Environment Record office."

# gardening...



The gardening experts at have put together the must-do gardening jobs to help get outside space ready for late Spring and Summer.

The tasks include giving the lawn some care after the chilly months, protecting tender plants from any late frosts and adding mulch to flower beds.

For those growing their own fruit and vegetables, April is the month to plant early tomatoes, plant perennials and scented plants like lavender.



### 10 gardening jobs for this month:

### 1.Repair the lawn

Winter weather can damage the lawn and April is the time to repair it. If you haven't given the lawn its first cut, now's the time to do it but keep the mowing height on the high side. For any bare patches, either re-turf or sow lawn seed.

### 2. Late frost protection

There can be the odd late frost in April, so remember to protect tender plants. This may mean wrapping them up in their winter fleece and moving (potted plants) to sunnier spots in the garden.

### 3. Keep an eye on the weeds

Weeds make their return during the Spring so keep an eye on these over the coming weeks. Remove the weeds by either digging them up or try creating a homemade weed killer with baking soda.

### 4. Clear the patio

You'll want to clear the patio in case we get the occasional sunny spell throughout April. Use a water pressure to lift tough stains and dirt. Alternatively fill a bucket with some warm water and soap, pour onto the patio and begin scrubbing with a stiff broom.

### 5. Plant chives

Try planting chives and other herbs and letting them germinate on a sunny window sill or in the greenhouse. Take care though to sow them sparingly, thinning them out if they become overcrowded.

### 6. Mulch borders

Mulching soil saves water, improves it, and most importantly, suppresses weeds. April is the best time to apply it, as the unpredictable weather means it traps moisture from rain but stops beds from drying out in the sun.

### 7. Plant tomatoes

Plant tomatoes in a sunny spot or in the greenhouse. You can start them off from seed and plant them out once they're around 15cm tall. Do keep an eye on the conditions and introduce them to outside temperatures slowly. They thrive in warmer weather.

### 8. Bird feeders

Bird feeders normally take about two to four weeks to become inhabited by birds and can make a lovely feature in the garden. Get set up now for lots of summer visits from feathered friends.



The ground is warm enough in April for new lavender plants to flourish. Starting with a healthy plant with a pre-developed root system will help as well as planting one to three feet apart depending on the variety.

### 10. Plant perennials

Like Lavender, April is the best time to plant perennials due to the ground being moist enough for them to flourish. Planting now should see them bloom in a few months.


Music for Everyone (MfE), the Nottingham-based independent educational charity, celebrates an amazing 40 years of making and performing music in July 2023.

SPOTTED DOG ART GROUP MAY WORKSHOP

Colour and Pattern in Painting. Tutor: Claire Leggett Saturday 20th May 2023 10.00am to 4.00pm

In this one day class we play with colour and pattern juxtaposing one against the other to create harmonious or contrasting palettes for simple still life setups.

Using a water-based medium we will create form and depth through shading before layering colour and pattern on top, this will include learning to use masking fluid.

### You will need to bring:

- A water-based painting medium of your choice.
- · Brushes, water pot, pencil etc
- · Some masking fluid or 50p for a small amount of mine.
- An old brush or plastic applicator for the masking fluid it will gum up any brush you use.
- A couple of cotton buds.
- A clean, old cotton cloth to rub the masking fluid off if you don't want to use your hands.
- Some watercolour paper of your choice preferably stretched ready on a board or pre-gummed pad. Stretched paper can expand and contract with water whilst also drying out again flat - ready and easy to work on. You can use a pad of paper, but it just may buckle a little.
- · A hair dryer to speed up the drying process.
- I will supply some china and fabric items for still life but you could also bring any still life items you wish to paint that are colourful (contrasting or harmonious colour palettes) including fabrics and papers, fruit and flowers.




