



Beeston's tallest structure - the 110ft high spire at Beeston Methodist Church on Chilwell Road – is being cleaned and repointed as part of a proposed programme of essential work to maintain and modernise the 121-year-old building.

Broxtowe Borough Council has granted planning permission for the redevelopment of the distinctive Victorian church, designed by Bradford architect William James Morley and opened in 1902.

The landmark spire became more visible after the demolition of several large mill buildings in the 1990s.

Andy Taylor, co-chair of the BMC Property Committee and a member of the Redevelopment Group, said: "Checks on the condition of the spire revealed that some repointing of the stonework had become necessary as well as surface cleaning to remove lichens, moss and some larger weeds. The work is being undertaken by ASC Steeplejacks, of Carlton."

The redevelopment project will focus on improvements to the church sanctuary and the main entrance at the side of the building. The church is currently expensive to heat. So, a new heating system will be installed and the church roof, which has come to the end of its natural life, will be re-slated and insulated. The church windows will be doubled-glazed and new low-energy lighting installed.

The worship area will be re-modelled to meet the needs of a 21st century Methodist church while enhancing its role as an important community asset. The side balconies will be removed, allowing the impressive stained-glass windows in these areas to be fully revealed and bring extra light into the church. A new level floor with insulation underneath will be installed to create a more flexible space, suitable for small and large group worship and a wide range of community events. The remaining ground floor pews will be removed and replaced with modern seating. The impressive pipe organ will undergo a complete overhaul as part of the redevelopment.

New audio-visual technology will facilitate live streaming of services and events, including concerts and other performances. The coffee bar area will be upgraded and automatic doors installed at the side entrance.

BMC, committed to making the building as accessible and eco-friendly as possible, is also considering fitting solar panels on some of the roofing towards the rear of the premises.

16th Nov – If Only I Could Hibernate: A Mongolian drama about an ambitious teenage boy who hopes to win a Physics competition for a scholarship, despite the wishes of his mother who needs him to work and support the family. Nominated for the Un Certain Regard award at Cannes 2023.

A heron artwork created from old bikes, a shopping trolley and other rubbish collected from the canal has completed the transformation of a neglected urban green space in Nottingham.

The Wilford Street Ramp project has seen the canalside location given a new lease of life through a partnership between Green Hustle Community Interest Company (CIC) and Canal & Rivers Trust.

Nottingham's bike maker Raleigh contributed £8,000 to the project which now features the heron created by local artist Michelle Reader from recycled Raleigh bike parts and other waste retrieved from the canal.

As well as reclaiming the space for the community, the project raises awareness about the importance of environmental stewardship. The site has been transformed with new habitats, wildlife zones, sensory and edible planting and child friendly interactive features.

Wilford Street Ramp, nestled by the canal near Nottingham City Centre, had long suffered from neglect, overrun by ivy and bramble. Recognising its potential as a biodiversity-rich haven, Green Hustle CIC, Canal & Rivers Trust, and local partners embarked on a journey to transform the space into a vibrant ecosystem teeming with native plants and wildlife habitats.

Adam Pickering, Green Hustle, said: "The Wilford Street Ramp Revamp is a shining example of how collaborative efforts and creative vision can transform neglected spaces into vibrant community hubs that celebrate nature and inspire sustainable living."

This ambitious project united the efforts of local artists, gardeners, and volunteers, alongside the expertise of organisations like Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust and Nottingham Open Spaces Forum. The venture has empowered the community, sparking conversations about sustainability and impacting the local environment positively. Stakeholders and volunteers joined forces to unlock the site's potential, culminating in the design by gardener Andy Callow from Sherwood Garden Consultancy.



The best lighting options for small gardens should be subtle and highlight specimen plants to create shadows and give the garden depth. To avoid taking up too much floor space you can opt for wall, hanging and fairy lights.

6.Positioning of the plants

Use perspective to your advantage by carefully positioning small, medium and larger plants in sequence. This creates an optical illusion and makes the garden look larger.

7.Grow herbs

Herbs are easy to grow and take up minimal space in the garden. You can plant herbs in containers or directly in the ground. Herbs are also great for vertical gardening.

8. Choose space-efficient furniture






